SPINNING TOP

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 53" x 60"

Finished Block Size 6" x 6"

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.pennyrosefabrics.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Toy Chest 10-Inch Stacker (10-4850-31)

1 1/4 yards (1.15 m) green bunny balloons (C4852 Green)

1/4 yard (25 cm) blue scotties (C4856 Blue)

2 3/8 yards (2.2 m) linen shade (C200-01 Linen)

Binding 5/8 yard (60 cm)

Backing 3 7/8 yards (3.55 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

10-Inch Stacker

Cut 2 squares 3" x 3" and 1 square 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" from each of the following assorted prints:

aqua birdie see-saw, red birdie see-saw,
green bunnies & flowers, yellow bunnies & flowers,
aqua bunny balloons, yellow bunny balloons,
aqua baby shoes, pink baby shoes, blue baby ducklings,
orange baby ducklings, yellow baby ducklings,
pink little lambs, red little lambs, yellow little lambs,
blue scotties, pink scotties, purple scotties, aqua sailboats,
blue sailboats, red sailboats

Cut 4 squares 3" x 3" and 2 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" from each of the following assorted prints:

green birdie see-saw, purple birdie see-saw,
pink bunnies & flowers, green bunny balloons,
orange bunny balloons, blue baby shoes,
orange baby shoes, pink baby ducklings, blue little lambs,
purple little lambs, red scotties

Green Bunny Balloons

Cut 5 strips 5 1/2" x WOF for Border 2.

Blue Scotties

Cut 2 strips 1 1/2" x WOF. Cut the strips into 30 squares 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" for posts.

Linen Shade

Cut 7 strips 3" x WOF. Cut the strips into 84 squares 3" x 3".

Cut 11 strips 2 1/2" x WOF. Cut the strips into 168 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2".

Cut 3 strips 6 1/2" x WOF. Cut the strips into 71 rectangles 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" for sashing.


Cut 5 strips 1 1/2" x WOF for Border 1.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of fabrics and blocks.


Spinning Top Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a linen shade 3" square. Place the linen shade 3" square on top of an assorted print 3" square. Sew 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut on line to make 2 Half Square Triangles. Press. Trim the Half Square Triangles to 2 1/2" square. Repeat to make 4 Half Square Triangles.



Half Square Triangle

Sew 4 Half Square Triangles, 4 linen shade 2 1/2" squares, and 1 assorted print 2 1/2" square together to create the Spinning Top Block. Make 42 Spinning Top Blocks.

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Spinning Top Block and Sashing

Refer to Quilt Center Diagram for block and sashing placement. Sew a Spinning Top Block to a linen shade $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Repeat to make a row with 6 Spinning Top Blocks and 5 sashing rectangles. Make 7 block and sashing rows.

Sashing and Posts

Refer to Quilt Center Diagram for sashing and post placement. Sew a linen shade $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to a blue scotties $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make a row with 6 sashing rectangles and 5 posts. Make 6 sashing and post rows.

Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to Quilt Center Diagram for row placement. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1


Side borders should be $48\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $43\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Border 2

Side borders should be $50\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $53\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose fabric from the Toy Chest Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
