1/2 pound figs  
8 apples

Four gold braids  
1 1/4 pound S. D. Cake Flour  
2 teaspoons baking powder

To mix fruit cake, cream butter and sugar; whip yolks; add to creamed butter and sugar; then add raisins; work in with hands; then currants, figs; next citron, next chopped apples, molasses, spices; then add brandy, mixing well; next put soda in milk; add milk and stir; then add mixture of eggs that have been whisked about

# Trends

## FINISHED QUILT SIZE 53" x 59½"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website [www.rileyblakedesigns.com](http://www.rileyblakedesigns.com) for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Trendsetter 10-inch Stacker (10-3990-15)

⅞ yard (85 cm) navy main (C3990 Navy)

½ yard (50 cm) linen shade (C200-01 Linen)

⅞ yard (85 cm) bottle green shade (C200-44 Bottle Green)

Binding ⅝ yard (60 cm)

Backing 3½ yards (3.05 m)

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting the border and sashing pieces.

### 10-inch Stacker

Cut 3 rectangles 3¼" x 10" from each assorted print 10" square.

### Navy Main

Cut 6 strips 4½" x WOF for Border 2.

### Linen Shade

Cut 5 strips 2½" x WOF for Border 1.

### Bottle Green Shade

Cut 11 strips 2" x WOF. Sew the strips together and cut into 9 rectangles 2" x 48" for sashing.

Cut 1 strip 5¼" x WOF. Cut the strip into 10 rectangles 3¼" x 5¼".

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of fabrics.

### Column A

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of fabrics as each column is a different arrangement of fabrics. Sew 5 assorted print 3¼" x 10" rectangles together to create Column A. Repeat to make 5 Column A's.

### Column B

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of fabrics as each column is a different arrangement of fabrics. Sew 4 assorted print 3¼" x 10"

rectangles and 2 bottle green shade 3¼" x 5¼" rectangles together to create Column B. Repeat to make 5 Column B's.

## Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the quilt photo for column placement. Layout the 5 Column A's, 5 Column B's, and 9 bottle green shade 2" x 48" sashing rectangles. Sew the columns together to complete the center of the quilt.

## Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

### Border 1

Side borders should be 48". Top and bottom borders should be 45½".

### Border 2

Side borders should be 52". Top and bottom borders should be 53½".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Trendsetter Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
