Starlight

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 56" x 56"

Finished Block Size 20" x 20"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1½ yards (1.4 m) coral main (C3580 Coral)

½ yard (30 cm) coral flower (C3581 Coral)

¾ yard (30 cm) green damask (C3582 Green)

½ yard (30 cm) yellow geometric (C3583 Yellow)

¾ yard (30 cm) coral squiggle (C3584 Coral)

½ yard (30 cm) coral dot (C3585 Coral)

¾ yard (30 cm) green dot (C3585 Green)

¾ yard (30 cm) yellow dot (C3585 Yellow)

½ yard (50 cm) yellow stripe (C3586 Yellow)

1½ yards (1.4 m) snow white shade (C200-03 Snow White)

Binding ¾ yard (60 cm)

Backing 3½ yards (3.2 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Starlight Block

Cut 1 square 10½" x 10½" from coral main

Cut 1 square 10½" x 10½" from yellow geometric

Cut 1 square 10½" x 10½" from coral dot

Cut 1 square 10½" x 10½" from coral flower

Cut 16 rectangles 5½" x 10½" from snow white shade

Cut 16 squares 5½" x 5½" from snow white shade

Cut 8 squares 5½" x 5½" from yellow dot

Cut 8 squares 5½" x 5½" from green damask

Cut 8 squares 5½" x 5½" from coral squiggle

Cut 8 squares 5½" x 5½" from green dot

Border 1

Cut 5 strips 2½" x WOF from yellow stripe

Border 2


Cut 6 strips 6½" x WOF from coral main

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics and blocks.


Starlight Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Refer to quilt photo as each block is a different combination of fabrics. Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of an assorted print 5½" square. Place the square on top of a snow white shade 5½" x 10½" rectangle and sew on the line. Leave a ¼" seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side. This will make 1 Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 4 Flying Geese Units.



Flying Geese Unit

Sew a Flying Geese Unit to the left and right side of an assorted print 10½" square. Sew a snow white shade 5½" square to each side of the 2 remaining Flying Geese Units. Sew the 3 rows together to complete the Starlight Block. Repeat to make 4 Starlight Blocks.



Starlight Block

Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to quilt photo for placement of blocks. Lay out blocks in 2 rows of 2 blocks. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 40½". Top and bottom borders should be 44½".

Border 2

Side borders should be 44½". Top and bottom borders should be 56½".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Valencia Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
