GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates or scan the QR Code for any updates before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. Due to the hand-crafted nature of batiks, the layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



WOF = Width of Fabric
RST = Right Sides Together
SNF-FG = Stitch and Flip Flying Geese

Fabric is from the Expressions Batiks Whispering Hallows collection unless stated otherwise.

2 ½ yards BTWB209 Hand-Dyes True Black (wide back backing)
Batting

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



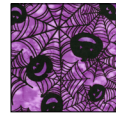
Dreamcatcher

Cut (3) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:
(42) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares. Label as A.



Oatmeal

Cut (4) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:
(60) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares. Label as B.



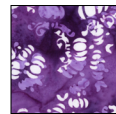
Glossy Grape

Cut (4) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:
(60) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares. Label as C.



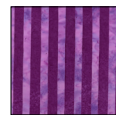
Tiger

Cut (2) 4 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:
(15) 4 ½" × 4 ½" squares. Label as D.



Grape Soda

Cut (2) 4 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:
(15) 4 ½" × 4 ½" squares. Label as E.



Lollipop

Cut (8) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:
(120) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares. Label as F.



Embrace the Gray

Cut (15) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:
(240) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares. Label as G.



Melon Swirl

Cut (15) 2 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:
(240) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares. Label as H.

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Dancing Lights

Cut (9) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(2) 4 1/2" x 86 1/2" strips. Label as I.

(2) 4 1/2" x 80 1/2" strips. Label as J.



Grey Whisper

Cut (69) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Subcut:

(71) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" rectangles. Label as K.

(360) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" rectangles. Label as L.

(120) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. Label as M.



Stormy Seas

Cut (17) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Set (9) aside for binding. From remaining strips, subcut:

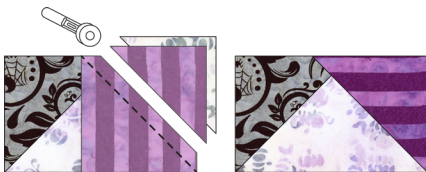
(120) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. Label as N.

SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a 1/4" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the fabrics. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Please refer to the following general sewing technique as this method is referenced throughout the pattern in its abbreviated form.

STITCH AND FLIP FLYING GEESSE METHOD (SNF-FG)

Draw a diagonal line, corner to corner, on the wrong side of (2) squares. Place (1) square in a corner of (1) rectangle, RST, matching raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance outside the sewn line to 1/4". Flip the square away from the rectangle and press, replacing the corner. Repeat with the second square in the opposite corner. The size of the original rectangle does not change.



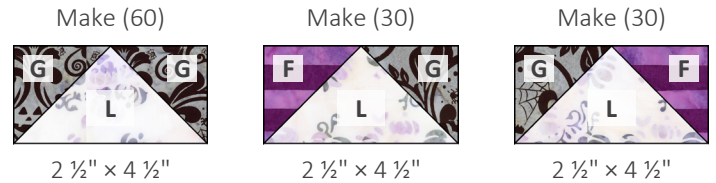
For horizontal stripes in a finished SNF-FG unit, arrange the stripes vertically when sewing.



For vertical stripes in a finished SNF-FG unit, arrange the stripes horizontally when sewing.

BLOCK ASSEMBLY

- Use the SNF-FG method to make the units shown below, referencing the diagrams for quantity, proper placement, and orientation of the stripes.



- Arrange (4) C-squares, (4) G/L SNF-FG units, and (1) D-square as shown below. Sew the squares and units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Purple Block Center. Repeat to make (15) total units.

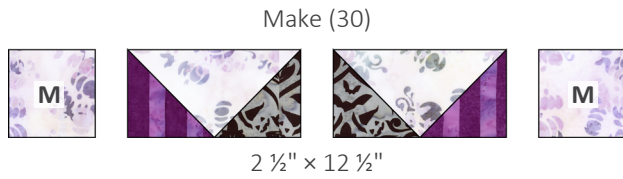


- Sew (1) of each F/G/L SNF-FG unit with horizontal stripes together as shown below to make (1) Purple Side Unit. Repeat to make (30) total units.



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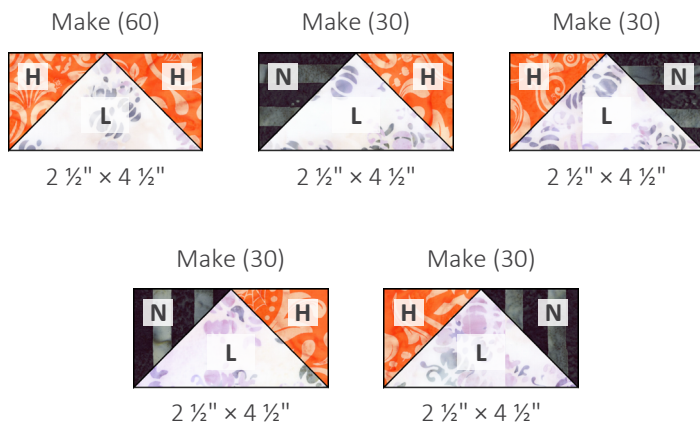
4. Sew (2) **M**-squares and (1) of each F/G/L SNF-FG unit with vertical stripes together as shown below to make (1) Purple Top/Bottom Unit. Repeat to make (30) total units.



5. Sew (1) Purple Side Unit to each side of (1) Purple Block Center as shown below. Next, sew (1) Purple Top/Bottom Unit to the top and bottom to make (1) Purple Block. Repeat to make (15) total blocks.



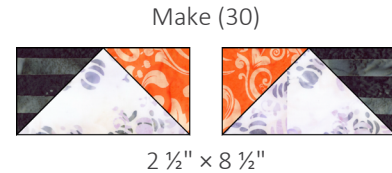
6. Use the SNF-FG method to make the units shown below, referencing the diagrams for quantity, proper placement, and orientation of the stripes.



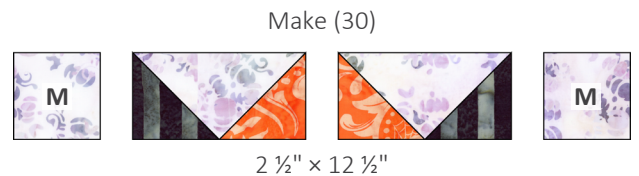
7. Arrange (4) **B**-squares, (4) H/L SNF-FG units, and (1) **E**-square as shown below. Sew the squares and units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Orange Block Center. Repeat to make (15) total units.



8. Sew (1) of each H/L/N SNF-FG unit with horizontal stripes together as shown below to make (1) Orange Side Unit. Repeat to make (30) total units.



9. Sew (2) **M**-squares and (1) of each H/L/N SNF-FG unit with vertical stripes together as shown below to make (1) Orange Top/Bottom Unit. Repeat to make (30) total units.



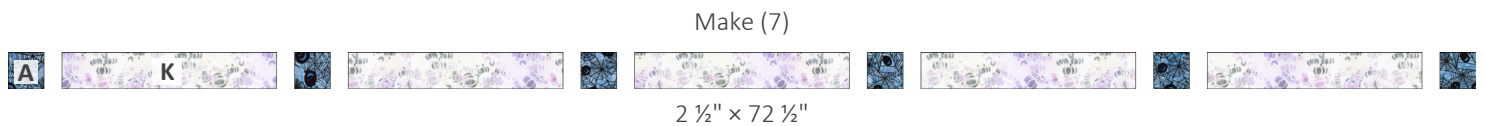

10. Sew (1) Orange Side Unit to each side of (1) Orange Block Center as shown, right. Next, sew (1) Orange Top/Bottom Unit to the top and bottom to make (1) Orange Block. Repeat to make (15) total blocks.

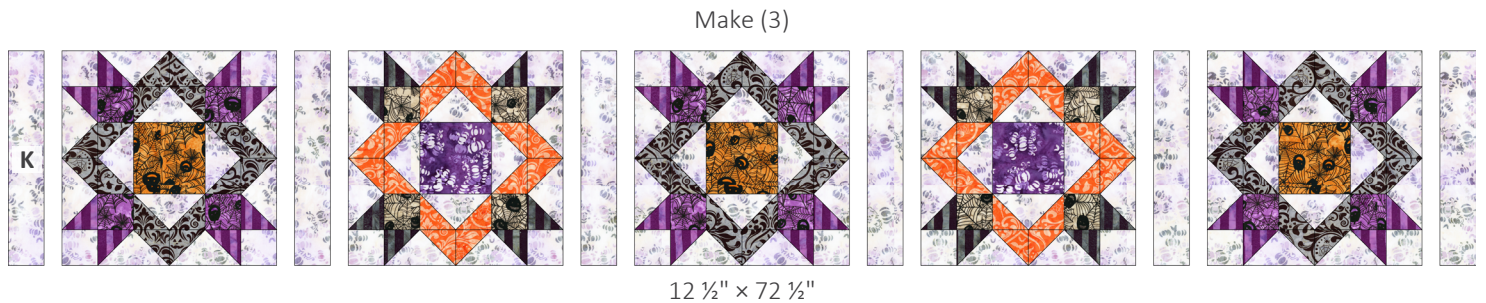


QUILT ASSEMBLY

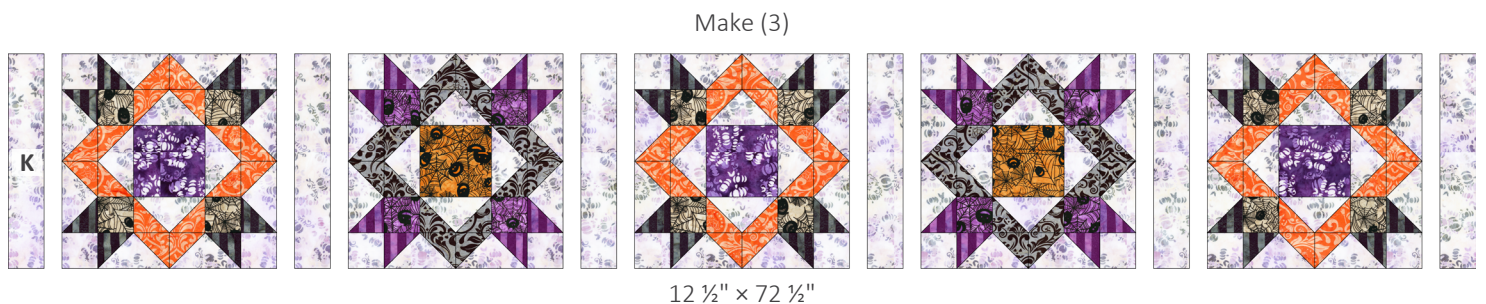
11. Sew (6) **A**-squares and (5) **K**-rectangles together as shown below to make (1) Sashing Row. Repeat to make (7) total rows.



12. Sew (6) **K**-rectangles, (3) Purple Blocks, and (2) Orange Blocks together as shown below to make (1) Block Row 1. Repeat to make (3) total rows.

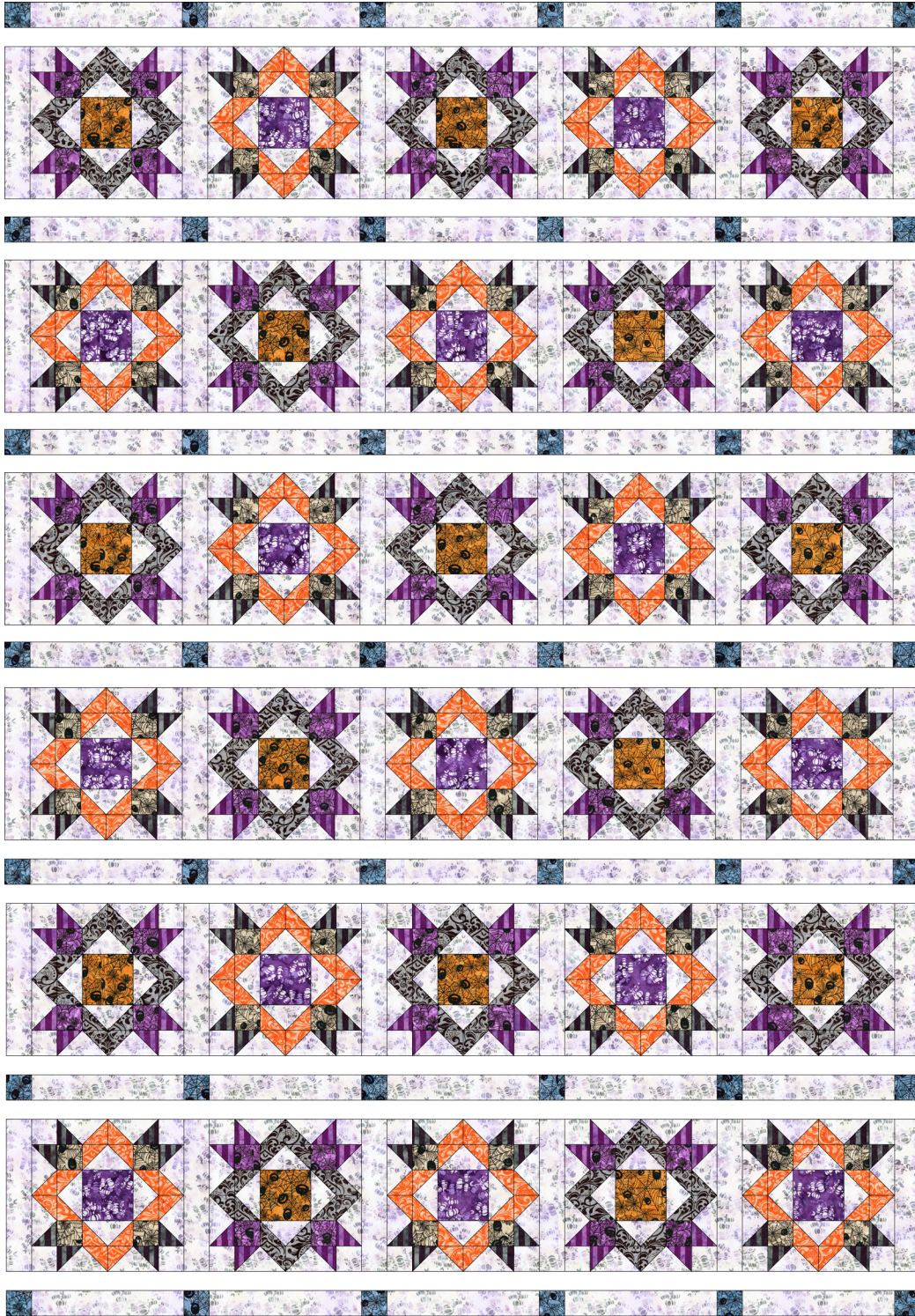


13. Sew (6) **K**-rectangles, (3) Orange Blocks, and (2) Purple Blocks together as shown below to make (1) Block Row 2. Repeat to make (3) total rows.



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14. Arrange (7) Sashing Rows, (3) Block Row 1s, and (3) Block Row 2s as shown below. Sew the rows together to make the quilt center.

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15. Sew (1) I-strip to each side of the quilt center as shown below. Next, sew (1) J-strip to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

16. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Stormy Seas binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
