# SMOKY VALLEY PANEL QUILT

## FINISHED QUILT SIZE 69" × 76"

Please read all instructions before beginning this project. Yardage calculated using a 42" usable width of fabric.

## GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Please check [www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates](http://www.rileyblakedesigns.com/pattern-updates) or scan the QR Code for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting techniques and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric. It is not recommended to prewash fabric before cutting and assembling.



Always verify your panel size before beginning. If your panel measurements differ from those given in the pattern, trim to the desired size or use coping strips to alter the size of your panel. If coping strips are needed, add oversized, coordinating strips of fabric to the necessary edges of the panel, then trim to the size specified in the pattern.

WOF = Width of Fabric  
RST = Right Sides Together  
SNF = Stitch and Flip  
HST = Half Square Triangle

All fabrics from the Wild Horses collection unless stated otherwise.

C200-HONEY Shades  
C455-GRAY Micro Gingham  
C505-CHARCOAL 1/8" Stripe on Ivory  
C505-HONEY 1/8" Stripe on Ivory  
C640-RILEYGRAY Dapple Dot  
C805-TEADYE POParazzi  
C15491-TEADYE Cowboy  
C15493-BROWN Bandana  
C15497-GRAPHITE Horseshoes

¼ yard C805-BUTTERSCOTCH POParazzi  
¾ yard C640-RAISIN Dapple Dot (includes binding)  
1 ¼ yard C15491-KHAKI Cowboy  
2 ¼ yards C650-CREAM Tone on Tone Dapple Dot

## OTHER SUPPLIES

Basic Sewing Supplies  
2 ½ yards Wide Back backing fabric of your choice  
(suggested WB12562-PEBBLE Bee Gingham)  
Batting

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

When cutting fabrics, use a straight edge ruler and rotary cutter. Measurements include ¼" seam allowance. Label, allocate, and organize all cuts as noted.



Smoky Valley Panel  
Fussy cut (1) panel 35" × 42", centered over the motif.\*

*\*Note: If the panel motif does not reach the edge of the required cut, add coping strips first and then trim to the required size once the strips are added.*



### Butterscotch Shades

Cut (8) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares. Label as A.



### Honey Shades

Cut (12) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares. Label as B.



### Gray Micro Gingham

Cut (8) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares. Label as C.



### Charcoal 1/8" Stripe on Ivory

Cut (12) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares. Label as D.

**Honey 1/8" Stripe on Ivory**  
Cut (8) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. Label as E.



**Riley Gray Dapple Dot**  
Cut (12) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. Label as F.



**Tea Dye Poparazzi**  
Cut (12) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. Label as G.



**Tea Dye Cowboy**  
Cut (12) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. Label as H.



**Brown Bandana**  
Cut (12) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. Label as I.



**Graphite Horseshoes**  
Cut (12) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. Label as J.



**Butterscotch Poparazzi**  
Cut (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip; subcut:  
(12) 1 1/4" x 3 1/2" rectangles. Label as K.  
Cut (1) 2" x WOF strip; subcut:  
(16) 2" x 2" squares. Label as L.  
(8) 1 1/4" x 2" rectangles. Label as M.



**Raisin Dapple Dot**  
Cut (9) 2 1/2" x WOF strips; subcut (1) strip:  
(12) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. Label as N.  
Set (8) remaining strips aside for binding.



**Khaki Cowboy**  
Cut (7) 6" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end;  
subcut:  
(2) 6" x 65" strips. Label as O for Outer  
Side Borders.  
(2) 6" x 69" strips. Label as P for Outer  
Top/Bottom Borders.  
(8) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. Label as Q.



**Cream Tone on Tone Dapple Dot**  
Cut (3) 9 1/2" x WOF strips; subcut:  
(4) 5 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles. Label as R.  
(32) 2" x 9 1/2" strips. Label as S.  
(4) 1 3/4" x 9 1/2" strips. Label as T.  
(4) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" strips. Label as U.  
(8) 2" x 7 1/4" strips. Label as V.  
Cut (2) 6 1/2" x WOF strips; subcut:  
(4) 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. Label as W.  
(32) 2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. Label as X.  
Cut (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips; subcut:  
(64) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. Label as Y.  
Cut (2) 2 1/4" x WOF strips; subcut:  
(2) 2 1/4" x 37 1/2" strips. Label as Z for  
Panel Top/Bottom Borders.  
Cut (3) 2" x WOF strips; subcut:  
(63) 2" x 2" squares. Label as AA.  
Cut (1) more 2" x 2" square from a 9 1/2"  
scrap; (64) total 2" x 2" squares are  
required.  
Cut (6) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-  
end; subcut:  
(2) 1 3/4" x 63 1/2" strips. Label as BB for  
Middle Side Borders.  
(2) 1 3/4" x 42" strips. Label as CC for  
Panel Side Borders.  
Cut (5) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Piece (3) together end-  
to-end; subcut:  
(2) 1 1/4" x 58" strips. Label as DD for  
Middle Top/Bottom Borders.  
From remaining (2) strips subcut:  
(8) 1 1/4" x 3 1/2" rectangles. Label as EE.  
(32) 1 1/4" x 1 1/4" squares. Label as FF.

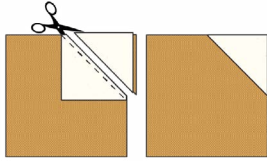
## SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a 1/4" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the quilt layout diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Please refer to the following general sewing techniques as these methods are referenced throughout the pattern in their abbreviated form.

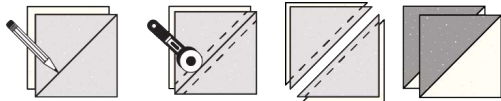
## STITCH AND FLIP METHOD (SNF)

Place (2) pieces RST, matching raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the smaller piece across the corner. Stitch on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance outside the sewn line to  $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Flip the square away from the rectangle and press, replacing the corner. The size of the larger, original piece does not change.



## 2-AT-A-TIME HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE METHOD (HST)

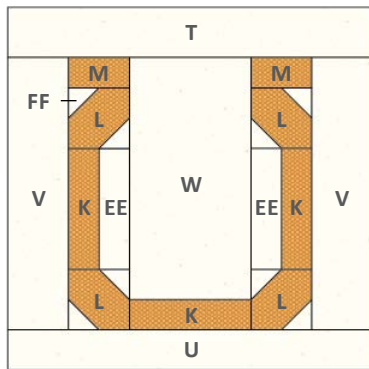
Place (2) squares RST. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) square. Stitch  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line to create (2) HSTs. Press toward the darker fabric. Trim HSTs to the indicated size.



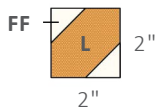
## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

### HORSESHOE BLOCK

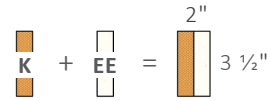
$9\frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$   $9\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.  
Make (4) blocks.



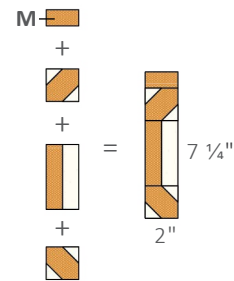
1. Gather (1) **L**-square and (2) **FF**-squares. Using the SNF method, replace the top left and bottom right corners of the **L**-square with the **FF**-squares, using the diagram below for proper placement and orientation. Repeat to make (16) total SNF Units. Set aside.



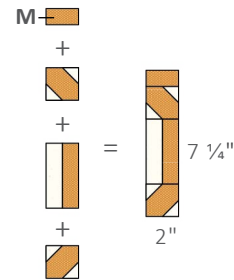
2. Gather (1) **K**-rectangle and (1) **EE**-rectangle. Sew together, referencing the diagram below for proper placement and orientation. Press. Repeat to make (8) total Two-Patch Units.



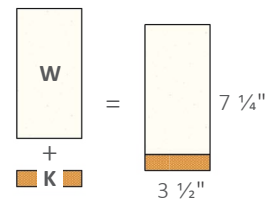
3. Gather (2) SNF Units, (1) Two-Patch Unit, and (1) **M**-rectangle. Sew together, referencing the diagram below for proper placement and orientation. Press. Repeat to make (4) total Left Side Units. Set aside.



4. Repeat Step 3 to create the unit shown below, referencing the diagram for proper placement and orientation. Press. Repeat to make (4) total Right Side Units. Set aside.

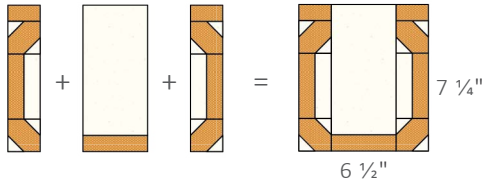


5. Gather (1) **K**-rectangle and (1) **W**-rectangle. Sew together, referencing the diagram below for proper placement and orientation. Press. Repeat to make (4) total Middle Units.

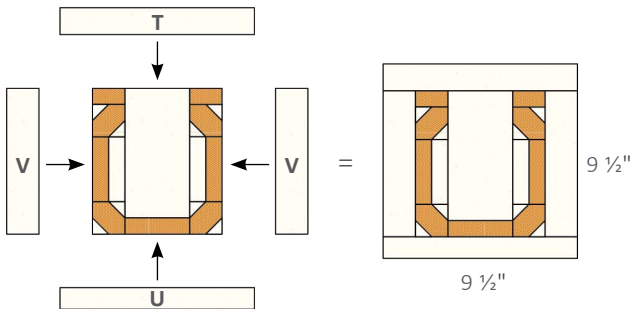

6. Gather (1) Left Side Unit, (1) Right Side Unit, and (1) Middle Unit. Sew together, referencing the diagram below for proper placement and orientation. Press. Repeat to make (4) total Horseshoe Units.



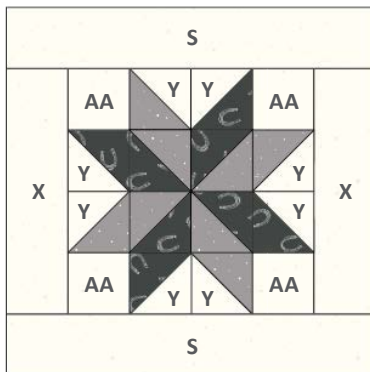
7. Gather (1) T-strip, (1) U-strip, and (2) V-strips. Sew the V-strips to the sides of (1) Horseshoe Unit. Press. Then sew the T- and U-strips to the top and bottom of the Horseshoe Unit. Press. Repeat to make (4) total Horseshoe Blocks. Set aside.



## STAR BLOCK

9 1/2" x 9 1/2" unfinished.  
Make (16) blocks.

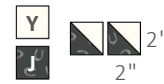
Use the chart on page 6 for Star Block fabric combinations.



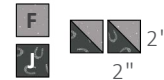
8. Gather (1) F-square and (1) Y-square. Use the HST method to create the Star 1 Units shown below. Press. Trim to 2" x 2". Repeat to make (4) total Star 1 Units. Set aside.



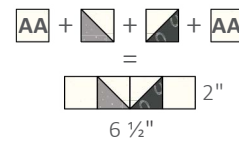
9. Repeat Step 8 with (1) J-square and (1) Y-square to create the Star 2 Units shown below. Press. Trim to 2" x 2". Repeat to make (4) total Star 2 Units. Set aside.



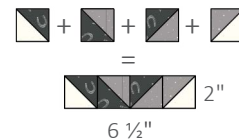
10. Repeat Step 8 with (1) F-square and (1) J-square to create the Star 3 Units shown below. Press. Trim to 2" x 2". Repeat to make (4) total Star 3 Units. Set aside.



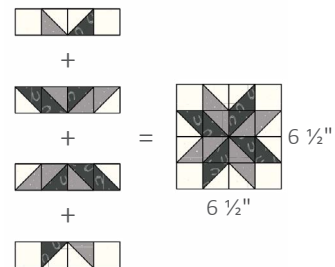
11. Gather (2) AA-squares, (1) Star 1 Unit, and (1) Star 2 Unit. Sew together, referencing the diagram below for proper placement and orientation. Press. Repeat to make (2) total Star Row 1 Units. Set aside.



12. Gather (1) Star 1 Unit, (1) Star 2 Unit, and (2) Star 3 Units. Sew together, referencing the diagram below for proper placement and orientation. Press. Repeat to make (2) total Star Row 2 Units.

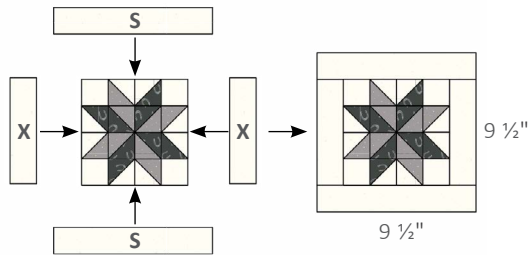


13. Gather (2) Star Row 1 Units and (2) Star Row 2 Units. Sew together, referencing the diagram below for proper placement and orientation. Press to make (1) Star Unit.

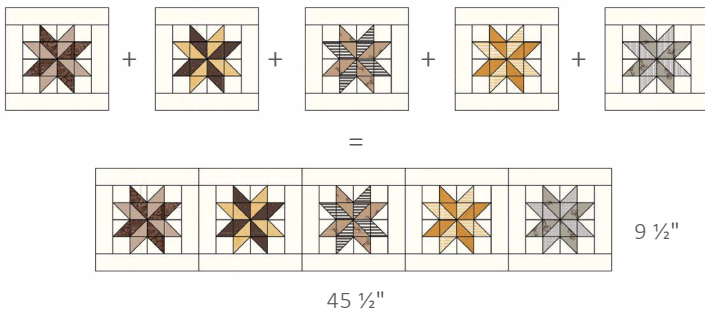
14. Gather (2) **S**-strips and (2) **X**-strips. Sew the **X**-strips to the sides of the Star Unit. Press. Then sew the **S**-strips to the top and bottom of the Star Unit. Press. Set aside.



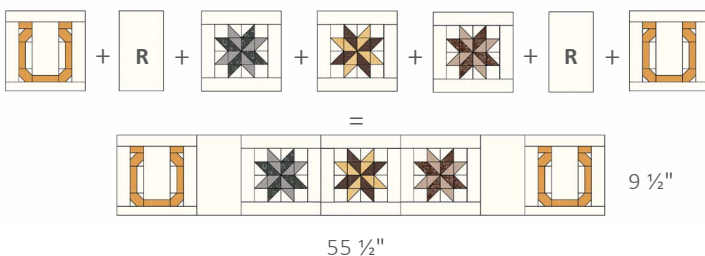
15. Repeat steps 8-14 to make (16) total Star Blocks. Refer to the chart on page 6 for the fabric combinations used to create the cover quilt.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

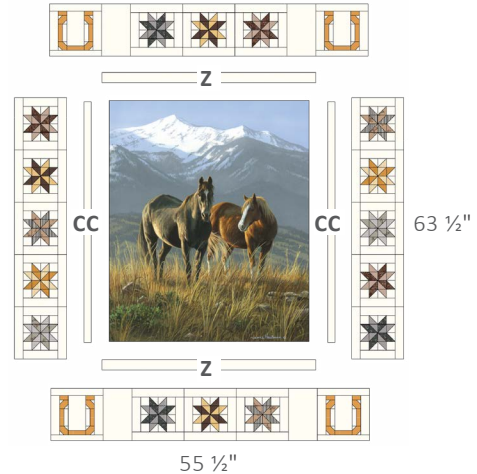
16. Gather (5) Star Blocks. Sew together, referencing the diagram below and the Quilt Layout Diagram on page 7 for proper placement and orientation. Repeat to make (2) total Star Rows. Set aside.



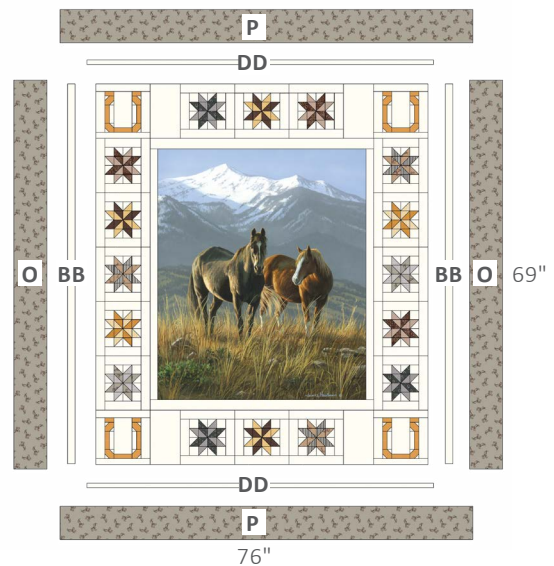
17. Gather (3) Star Blocks, (2) Horseshoe Blocks, and (2) **R**-rectangles. Sew together, referencing the diagram below and the Quilt Layout Diagram on page 7 for proper placement and orientation. Press. Repeat to make (2) total Horseshoe Rows. Set aside.



18. Gather the Panel, (2) **Z**-strips, (2) **CC**-strips, (2) Star Rows, and (2) Horseshoe Rows. Sew the **CC**-strips to the sides of the Panel. Press. Then sew the **Z**-strips to the top and bottom of the Panel. Press. Next, sew the Star Rows to the sides of the Quilt Center. Press. Then sew the Horseshoe Rows to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center. Press.



19. Gather the Quilt Center, (2) **O**-strips, (2) **P**-strips, (2) **BB**-strips, and (2) **DD**-strips. Sew the **BB**-strips to the sides of the Quilt Center. Press. Then sew the **DD**-strips to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center. Press. Next, sew the **O**-strips to the sides of the Quilt Center. Press. Then sew the **P**-strips to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center. Press.

## FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

20. Finish the quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the Raisin Dapple Dot binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.

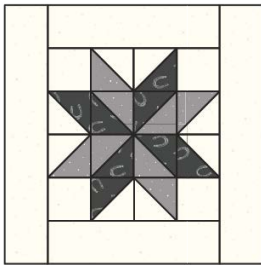

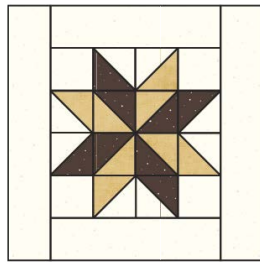

& Graphite Horseshoes (J)



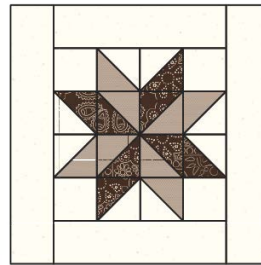
### STAR BLOCKS 2 & 5

& Honey Shades (B)



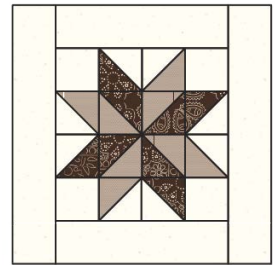
### STAR BLOCKS 3 & 12

& Brown Bandana (I)



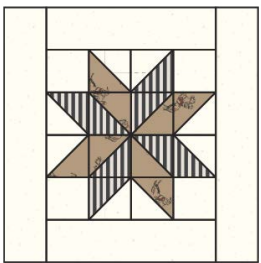
### STAR BLOCKS 4

& Tea Dye Poparazzi (G)



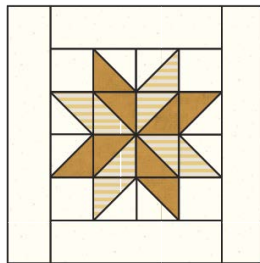
### STAR BLOCKS 6 & 16

& Charcoal 1/8 Stripe on Ivory (D)



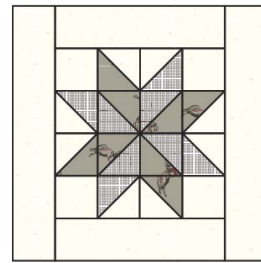
### STAR BLOCKS 7 & 10

& Honey 1/8 Stripe on Ivory (E)



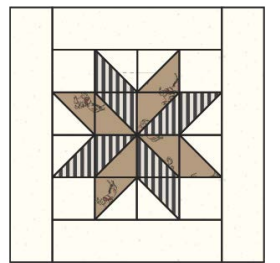
### STAR BLOCKS 8

& Gray Micro Gingham (C)



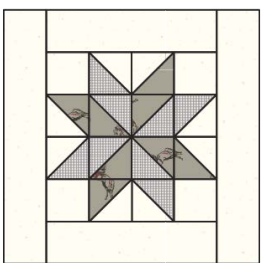
### STAR BLOCKS 9

& Tea Dye Cowboy (H)



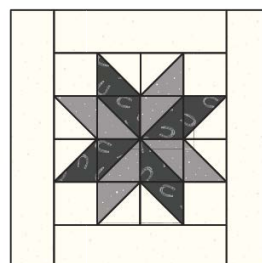
### STAR BLOCKS 11

& Khaki Cowboy (Q)



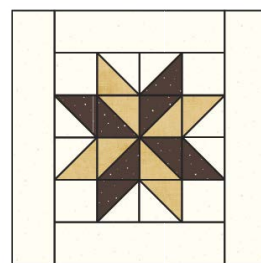
### STAR BLOCKS 14
