## FINISHED QUILT SIZE 471/2" x 571/2"

Measurements include $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance.
Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com/ pattern-updates for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

5/8 yard Green Main (F10630 Green)
$3 / 4$ yard Parchment Main (F10630 Parchment)
7/8 yard Mint Toss (F10631 Mint)
$3 / 8$ yard Brown Leaf (F10632 Brown)
$1 / 8$ yard Parchment Leaf (F10632 Parchment)
1/8 yard Brown Wood Grain (F10633 Brown)
¼ Yard Green Wood Grain (F10633 Green)
1 yard Navy Wood Grain (F10633 Navy)*
$1 / 4$ yard Blue Plaid (F10634 Blue)
¼ yard Mint Plaid (F10634 Mint)

* Includes binding


## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting.
WOF - width of fabric.

Label pieces as they are cut.

## Green Main

Cut 1 strip 20" x WOF.
Sub-cut from strip:

$$
1-18^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime} \text { panel (A) }
$$

## Parchment Main

Cut 1 strip 24 " x WOF.
Sub-cut from strip:
$1-9^{\prime \prime} \times 24^{\prime \prime}$ panel (B)
$1-9 " \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ panel (C)

## Mint Toss

Cut 1 strip $18^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF.
Sub-cut from strip:
1-18" x $24^{\prime \prime}$ panel (D)
Cut 2 strips $6^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF.
Sub-cut from strips:
1-6" x 31" rectangle (E)
$1-6^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (F)

## Brown Leaf

Cut 2 strips 6" x WOF.
Sub-cut from strips:
$1-6^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (G)
$1-6^{\prime \prime} \times 24^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (H)
$1-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (I)
$1-2^{\prime \prime} \times 6^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (J)

## Parchment Leaf

Cut 1 strip $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF.
Sub-cut from strip:
1-31/2" $\times 18^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (K)
$1-3 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 13^{1} / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (L)
$1-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 9^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (M)

## Brown Wood Grain

Cut 1 strip $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF.
Sub-cut from strip:
$1-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 18^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (N)
1-3 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 131 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (O)
$1-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (P)

## Green Wood Grain

Cut 2 strips $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF.
Sub-cut from strips:
$1-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 24^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle ( Q )
$1-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (R)
1-31/2" square (S)
$2-2^{\prime \prime} \times 312^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (T)

## Navy Wood Grain

Cut 6 strips $21 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF for Binding.
Cut 6 strips 2" x WOF.
Sub-cut from strips:
3-2" $\times 24^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (U)
3-2" x 20" rectangles (V)
2-2" $\times 18^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (W)
2-2" $\times 9^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles (X)
6-2" squares $(\mathrm{Y})$

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## Blue Plaid

Cut 1 strip 6" x WOF.
Sub-cut from strip:
$1-6^{\prime \prime} \times 291 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (Z)
$1-6^{\prime \prime} \times 13^{1 / 2 \prime \prime}$ rectangle (AA)

## Mint Plaid

Cut 2 strips $312^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF.
Sub-cut from strips:
$1-3 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 24^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (AB)
$1-3 \frac{1}{2} / \prime \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle (AC)
2-2" x 3½" rectangles (AD)

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for the placement of prints.

Refer to the quilt layout diagram when constructing the quilt sections. Press seam allowances open.

## Section 1

Sew together, in order, the C panel and the R and 1 V rectangle to make Unit 1 ( $131 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ ).

Sew together 1 X and T rectangle and 1 Y square. Sew to the bottom of the O rectangle to make Unit $2\left(131 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}\right)$.

Sew Unit 1 to the top of Unit 2. Sew to the left edge of the $F$ rectangle to complete Section 1 ( $\left.19^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$.

## Section 2

Sew a V rectangle to each side of the AC rectangle to make Unit 3 ( $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}$ ).

Sew a $Y$ square to each side of 1 AD rectangle. Sew to the bottom of the $P$ rectangle to make Unit $4\left(61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}\right)$.

Sew Unit 3 to the top of Unit 4. Sew to the left edge of the G rectangle to complete Section 2 ( $\left.12^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$.

## Section 3

Sew together the A panel and the N and 1 W rectangle to complete Section 3 ( $18^{\prime \prime} \times 241 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ).

## Section 4

Sew together the $M$ rectangle, $S$ square and $L$, $I$ and $K$ rectangles to complete Section 4 ( $\left.48^{\prime \prime} \times 311 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$.

## Section 5

Sew together 1 X and T rectangle and 1 Y square. Sew to the top of the AA rectangle to make Unit 5 ( $\left.131 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$.

Sew together the $B$ panel and the $Q$ and $1 U$ rectangle to make Unit 6 ( $131 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 24^{\prime \prime}$ ).

Sew Unit 5 to the top of Unit 6 . Sew to the left edge of the $E$ rectangle to complete Section 5 ( $19^{\prime \prime} \times 31^{\prime \prime}$ ).

## Section 6

Sew together, in order, 1 Y square, 1 AD rectangle, 1 Y square, the $J$ and 1 W rectangle. Sew to the top of the $Z$ rectangle to make Unit 7 ( $\left.291 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$.

Sew together $1 \mathrm{U}, \mathrm{AB}, 1 \mathrm{U}$, and H rectangles and the D panel to make Unit 8 ( $291 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 24^{\prime \prime}$ ).

Sew Unit 7 to the top of Unit 8 to complete Section 6 ( $291 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31^{\prime \prime}$ ).

## Quilt Top

Sew Sections 1, 2 and 3 together into a row.

Sew Sections 5 and 6 together into a row.

Sew Section 4 between the 2 rows to complete the Quilt Top ( $48^{\prime \prime} \times 58^{\prime \prime}$ ).

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with the Navy Wood Grain strips. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
