(F) Confetti Cottons Brownie (C120-BROWNIE)

(2) $2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
(4) $21 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares
(2) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
(2) $1 \frac{1}{4^{\prime \prime}} \times 6 \frac{1}{2^{\prime \prime}}$ strips
$B+E$
(1) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ square

C,D,F,G,H,I,J+K
(1) $21 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square

12" Block
(2) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
(4) $33 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ squares
(2) $4^{\prime \prime}$ squares
(2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips
(1) $4^{\prime \prime}$ square
(1) $33 / 4$ " squares
(G) Confetti Cottons Beach (C120-BEACH)
(H) Shabby Raisin (C605-RAISIN)
(I) Bee Cross Stitch Raisin (C745-RAISIN)
(J) Confetti Cottons Latte (C120-LATTE)
(K) Confetti Cottons Licorice (C120-LICORICE)

Additional Tools Needed: Basic Sewing Supplies Use $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ seam allowance unless otherwise noted.
HST = Half Square Triangle
RST = Right Sides Together

## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Place (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}\left(4^{\prime \prime}\right) A$ square and (1) B square RST. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the B square. Stitch $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press toward the darker fabric. Trim HST to measure 2" x 2" ( 3 ½" x $31 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime}$ ). Make a total of (2) A/B - HSTs.
2. Repeat step 1 , replacing with $A / E$ square. Make a total of (2) A/E - HSTs.

3. Place (1) $21 / 4^{\prime \prime}\left(33^{\prime \prime}\right)$ A square and (1) C square RST. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the $C$ square. Stitch on the drawn line. Cut $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the drawn line. Press toward the darker fabric. Trim HST to measure 2" x $2^{\prime \prime}$ ( $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ).
4. Repeat step 3 , replacing with the following pairs: $A / D, A / F$, $\mathrm{G} / \mathrm{H}, \mathrm{I} / \mathrm{J}$, and $\mathrm{A} / \mathrm{K}$ squares. Make (1) HST per fabric pairing.

5. Following the illustration below, arrange (2) $2^{\prime \prime}\left(31 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right) \mathrm{A}$ squares and all HSTs. Note orientation of each HST. Sew together in rows, then sew rows together to create the heart unit.

6. Take (2) A strips and sew to the top and bottom of the heart
