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FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

C660-CHRISTMAS

(Fabric 1)

C120-CLOVER (Fabric 2)

C120-RILEYRED (Fabric 3)

C120-SAGE (Fabric 4)

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 1:

- A – (1) 4 ½" x 7" rectangle
- B – (1) 3 ½" x 7" rectangle
- C – (1) 2 ½" x 7" rectangle
- D – (4) 2 ½" x 3 ½" rectangles
- E – (1) 1 ½" x 13" rectangle
- F – (1) 1 ½" x 7" rectangle
- G – (4) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles

Fabric 2:

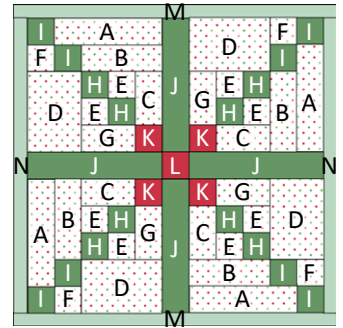
- H – (1) 1 ½" x 13" rectangle
- I – (2) 1 ½" x 7" rectangles
- J – (4) 1 ½" x 5 ½" rectangles

Fabric 3:

- K – (1) 1 ½" x 7" rectangle
- L – (1) 1 ½" x 1 ½" square

Fabric 4:

- M – (2) 1" x 12 ½" rectangles
- N – (2) 1" x 11 ½" rectangles

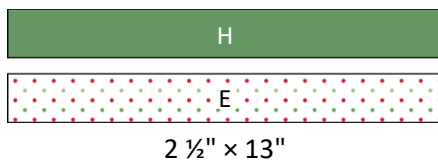


RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

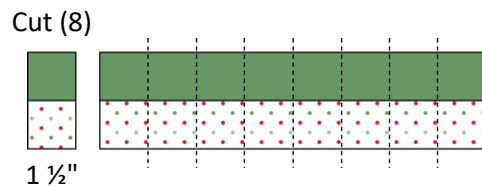
Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Sew (1) H-rectangle and (1) E-rectangle together as shown below to make (1) strip set.

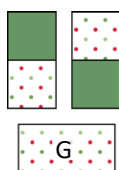


2. Cut the strip set into (8) 1 ½"-wide segments.



3. Sew (2) Step 2 segments together as shown below. Next, sew (1) G-rectangle to the bottom. Repeat to make (4) total units.

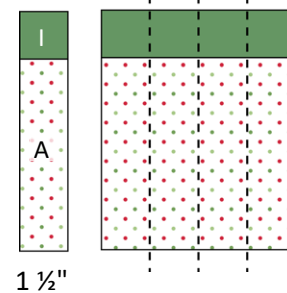

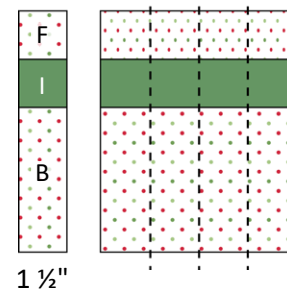

4. Repeat steps 1-2 to make the number of 1 ½"-wide segments as shown below, paying close attention to the order of the rectangles.

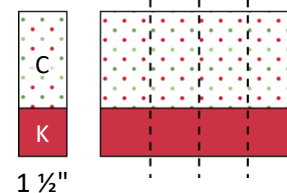

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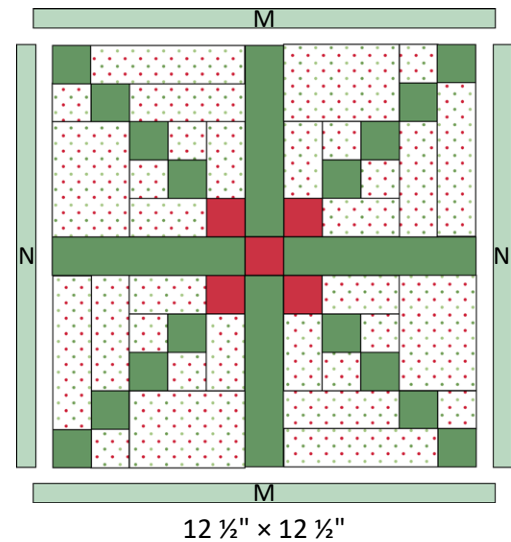
5. Sew (1) **D**-rectangle, (1) Step 3 unit, and (1) C/K segment together as shown below. Next, sew (1) A/I segment and (1) B/F/I segment to the top to make (1) Corner Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.



6. Arrange (4) Corner Units, (4) **J**-rectangles, and (1) **L**-square as shown below. Sew the units and pieces together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make the block center.



7. Sew (1) **N**-rectangle to each side of the block center as shown below. Next, sew (1) **M**-rectangle to the top and bottom to make the Day 12 block. The block should measure 12 1/2" x 12 1/2" unfinished.
