- D (1) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " × 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle
- $E (1) 1" \times 2"$ rectangle
- F − (4) 1" × 1 ¼" rectangles

- $G (1) 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle
- $H (1) 1" \times 2"$ rectangle

Fabric 4:

- $I (1) 1 \%" \times 8 \%"$ rectangle
- $J (1) 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 4 \frac{1}{4}" rectangle
- $K (1) 1 \%" \times 3 \%"$ rectangle
- L (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle
- M − (2) 1 ½" × 3" rectangles


- N (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangles
- O (2) 1 ½" × 2 ½" rectangles
- $P (1) 1 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 2" rectangle
- $Q (1) 1 \%" \times 1 \%"$ square
- $R (1) 1" \times 8 \%"$ rectangle
- $S (1) 1" \times 6"$ rectangle

- Y (2) 2 ½" × 6" rectangles
- $Z (2) 2 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 2 \frac{1}{2}" squares
- $AA (2) 2" \times 2"$ squares



- BB (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles
- CC (1) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " × 7" rectangle
- DD (2) 1 ¼" × 2" rectangles
- EE (2) 1" × 1 ½" rectangles
- FF (6) $1" \times 1"$ squares


RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

SNF = STITCH AND FLIP

Sew all seams RST and with a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Refer to the following general sewing technique as this method is referenced throughout the pattern in its abbreviated form.


STITCH AND FLIP METHOD INSTRUCTIONS (SNF)

Place (2) pieces RST, matching raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the smaller piece across the corner. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance outside the sewn line to ¼". Flip the smaller piece away from the larger piece and press, replacing the corner. The size of the larger, original piece does not change.



SEWING INSTRUCTIONS


1. Gather the required pieces and use the SNF method to make (1) of each unit shown below, referencing the diagrams for proper placement and orientation.






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2. Sew (1) **CC**-rectangle, (1) B/FF SNF unit, and (1) **W**-rectangle together as shown below.



3. Arrange (2) X-rectangles, (1) Step 2 unit, (2) DD-rectangles, and (1) D/FF SNF unit as shown below. Sew the rectangles and units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Hat Unit.




4. Sew (1) V-rectangle and (1) F-rectangle together as shown below. Repeat to make a second unit.




5. Arrange (2) F-rectangles, (1) U-rectangle, (2) V-rectangles, and (1) **E**-rectangle as shown below. Sew the rectangles together into rows. Next, sew the rows together.




6. Gather the required pieces, SNF unit, and step 4-5 units and arrange them as shown below. Sew the pieces and units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Snowman Face Unit.



7. Use the SNF method to sew (1) **AA**-square to each top corner and (1) **Z**-square to each bottom corner of (1) Snowman Face Unit as shown below.



8. Sew (2) Y-rectangles and (1) Snowman Face Unit together as shown below to make (1) Snowman Head Unit.






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
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9. Gather the required pieces and SNF units and arrange them as shown below. Sew the pieces and units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Scarf Unit.



2" × 12 ½"

10. Sew (1) Hat Unit, (1) Snowman Head Unit, and (1) Scarf Unit together as shown below to make the Day 5 block. The block should measure 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
