FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

C555-RED (Fabric 1)

C120-TIMBERLINE (Fabric 2)

C120-SAGE (Fabric 3)

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS Fabric 1*:

- $A (1) 6 \%" \times 2 \%"$ rectangle
- B (1) 6" \times 2 ½" rectangle
- C − (1) 4 ¼" × 2 ½" rectangle
- D − (1) 2 ¼" × 2 ½" rectangle
- E (1) 1 %" × 2 %" rectangle


Fabric 2:

- $F (2) 3 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
- $G (1) 2" \times 2 \%"$ rectangle
- H − (4) 1 ½" × 3 ½" rectangles

- $I (2) 1 \%" \times 1 \%"$ squares
- J (4) 1" × 1 ¼" rectangles

Fabric 3:

- $K (1) 3 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle
- $L (1) 3 \%" \times 4 \%"$ rectangle
- M − (2) 2 ¾" × 3 ½" rectangles
- $N (2) 2 \frac{3}{4}$ " × 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares
- O (2) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares
- $P (1) 2 \frac{1}{4}$ " × 4 ½" rectangle
- Q (2) 2 1/4" × 2 1/4" squares
- $R (7) 1 \%" \times 1 \%"$ squares
- $S (1) 1" \times 12 \%"$ rectangle
- T − (2) 1" × 12" rectangles
- U − (2) 1" × 2" rectangles



RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

SNF = STITCH AND FLIP

Sew all seams RST and with a χ'' seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Refer to the following general sewing technique as this method is referenced throughout the pattern in its abbreviated form.


STITCH AND FLIP METHOD INSTRUCTIONS (SNF)

Place (2) pieces RST, matching raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the smaller piece across the corner. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance outside the sewn line to ¼". Flip the smaller piece away from the larger piece and press, replacing the corner. The size of the larger, original piece does not change.



SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Gather the required pieces and use the SNF method to make the units shown below, referencing the diagrams for quantity, proper placement, and orientation.



2. Sew (1) **P**—rectangle and (1) **D**—rectangle together as shown below.




2 ¼" × 6 ½"

Sew (1) A/Q SNF unit and (1) Step 2 unit together as shown below. Next, sew (1) C/Q/R SNF unit to the left side and (1) L-rectangle to the right side to make (1) Candy Cane Top Unit.



4. Sew (2) **J**-rectangles and (1) **U**-rectangle together as shown below. Repeat to make a second unit.



5. Sew (1) H/R/R SNF unit, (1) Step 4 unit, (1) H/R SNF unit (with the **R** piece on the left side), (1) F/N/O SNF unit (with the **O** piece on the top-left), and (1) **M**-rectangle together as shown below to make (1) Left Bow Unit.



6. Sew (1) H/R/R SNF unit, (1) Step 4 unit, (1) H/R SNF unit (with the **R** piece on the right side), (1) F/N/O SNF unit (with the **O** piece on the top-right), and (1) **M**-rectangle together as shown below to make (1) Right Bow Unit.




7. Sew (1) **E**-rectangle, (1) **G**-rectangle, and (1) B/I SNF unit together as shown below to make (1) Candy Cane Bottom Unit.






8. Sew (1) Left Bow Unit, (1) Candy Cane Bottom Unit, and (1) Right Bow Unit together as shown below to make (1) Bow Unit.



9. Sew (1) **K**-rectangle and (1) Bow Unit together as shown below. Next, sew (1) Candy Cane Top Unit to the top to make (1) Candy Cane Unit.



10. Sew (1) **T**-rectangle to each side of (1) Candy Cane Unit as shown below. Next, sew (1) **S**-rectangle to the top to make the Day 8 block. The block should measure 12 %" × 12 %" unfinished.
