FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

C120-CLOVER (Fabric 1)

C120-CLOUD (Fabric 2)

C120-RILEYRED (Fabric 3)

C495-CHRISTMAS

(Fabric 4)



RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER
WOF = WIDTH OF FABRIC

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 1:

Cut (4) 1 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 32" rectangles. Label as A.

Fabric 2:

Cut (27) 1 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(22) 1 %" × 39" rectangles. Label as B.

(5) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " × 32" rectangles. Label as C.

Fabric 3:

Cut (11) 1 ½" × WOF strips. Subcut:

(11) 1 ½" × 39" rectangles. Label as D.

Fabric 4:


Cut (6) 2 ½" × WOF strips for binding.

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS


1. Sew (2) **C**—rectangles and (1) **A**—rectangle together as shown below to make (1) strip set. Repeat to make a second strip set.

Make (2)


C 3 ½" × 32" 2. Cut the strip sets into (40) 1 ½"-wide segments.



3. Repeat steps 1-2 to make the number of segments as shown below, paying close attention to the order of the rectangles.




Make (11) strip sets



Cut into (31) 12 ½"-wide segments

4. Sew (2) C/A/C segments and (1) A/C/A segment together as shown below to make (1) Nine-Patch Unit. Repeat to make (20) total units.

5. Arrange (20) Nine-Patch Units, (31) B/D/B segments, and (12) blocks as shown below. Sew the units and blocks together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to complete the quilt top.



FINISH THE QUILT

6. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
