In this new video series, Cindy teaches you how to make nine, 12 " finished beginner-friendly quilt blocks.
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## Tools

Marking pencil, scissors, $31 / 2$ " Trim-it ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Ruler (STTI-5525), $121 / 2$ " Trim-it ${ }^{\text {TM }}$ Ruler (STTI-5532), rotary cutter, 16 " Rotating Cutting Mat (STCM-15983), iron and ironing board.

## Cutting Instructions

Cream: A- eight $3 ½$ squares

Storm: B- eight $31 / 2$ " squares
C- eight $13 / 4$ " squares


## Sewing Instructions

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the $C$ squares.
2. Place 1 C square on a corner of 1 A square right sides together. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the corner $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ from the stitched line. Flip the C triangle and press. Repeat to make 8 A units. Trim to $312^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$.
3. Lay out the $8 B$ squares and eight $A$ units. Sew together in rows. Sew the rows together to complete the Bow Tie Block ( $12 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ ).
