## **Tools**


Marking pencil, scissors, 3½" Trim-it™ Ruler (STTI-5525), 12½" Trim-it™ Ruler (STTI-5532), rotary cutter, 16" Rotating Cutting Mat (STCM-15983), iron and ironing board.

## **Cutting Instructions**

Cream: A- eight 3½" squares

Storm: B- eight 3½" squares

C- eight 1¾" squares



## **Sewing Instructions**

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the C squares.
- 2. Place 1 C square on a corner of 1 A square right sides together. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the corner ¼" from the stitched line. Flip the C triangle and press. Repeat to make 8 A units. Trim to 3½" x 3½".
- 3. Lay out the 8 B squares and eight A units. Sew together in rows. Sew the rows together to complete the Bow Tie Block  $(12\frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $12\frac{1}{2}$ ").
