

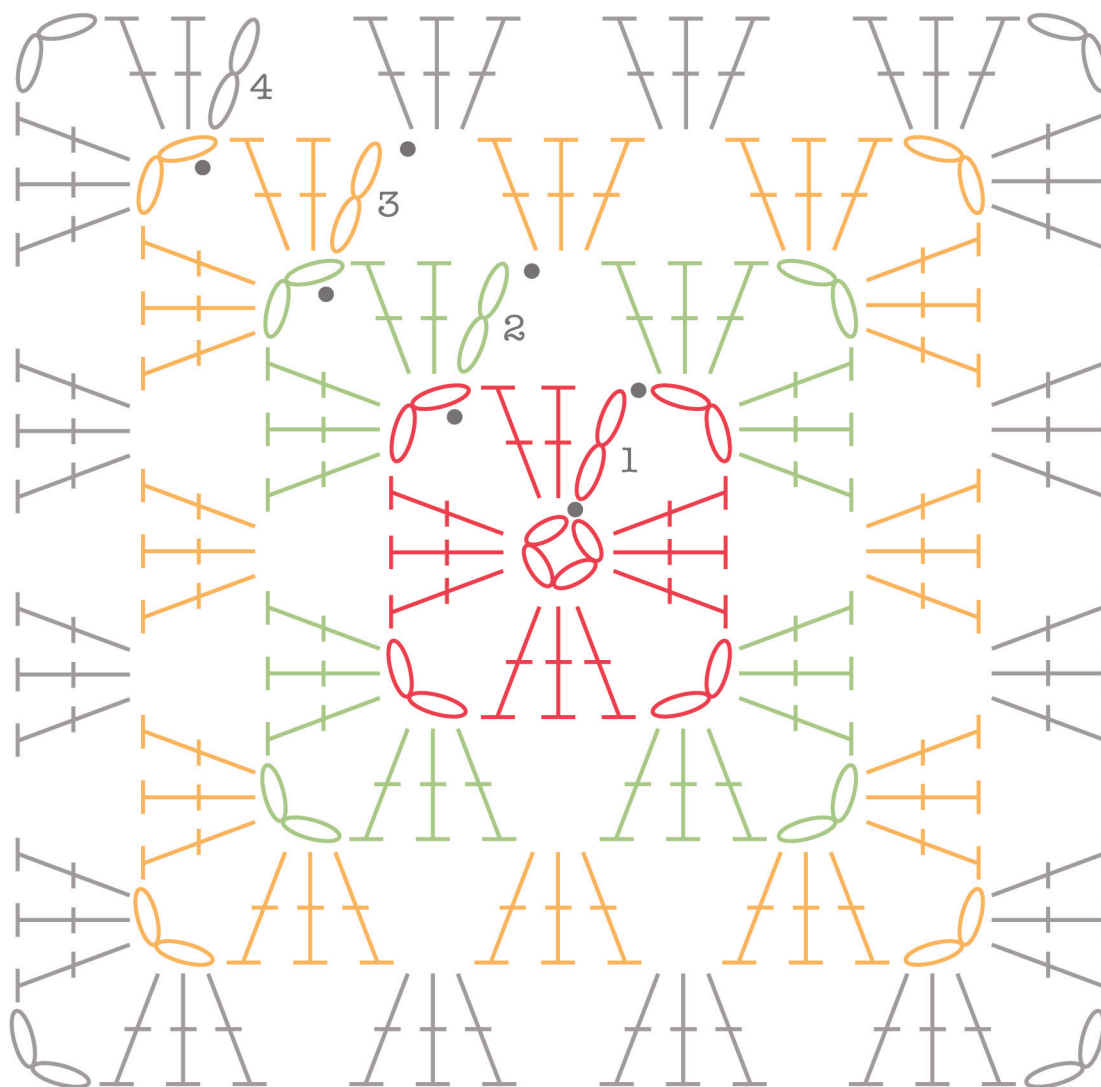
Chart Symbols & Instructions

*USA Terms

• Slip Stitch (slip st)	Insert hook into stitch or space indicated, yarn over, pull yarn through both loops on hook.
○ Chain Stitch (ch)	Yarn over, pull yarn through stitch on hook.
✕ Single Crochet (sc)	Insert hook into stitch or space indicated, yarn over, pull up a loop (2 loops on hook), yarn over, pull yarn through both loops on hook.
┐ Half Double Crochet (hdc)	Yarn over, insert hook into stitch or space indicated, pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), yarn over, pull yarn through all 3 loops on hook.
┐ Double Crochet (dc)	Yarn over, insert hook into stitch or space indicated, pull up a loop (3 loops on hook), *yarn over, pull yarn through 2 loops on hook; repeat from * once more.
┐ Triple Crochet (tc)	Yarn over twice, insert hook into stitch or space indicated, pull up a loop (4 loops on hook), *yarn over, pull yarn through 2 loops on hook; repeat from * two more times.
┐ Double Triple Crochet (dte)	Yarn over three times, insert hook into stitch or space indicated, pull up a loop (5 loops on hook), *yarn over, pull yarn through 2 loops on hook; repeat from * four more times.
