Butterfly Block

Materials

Fabrics listed are Confetti Cottons by Riley Blake


7" square Curry $7" \times 12"$ Pebble $7" \times 21"$ Le Creme

Tools

Marking pencil, scissors, ruler, rotary cutter and mat, iron and ironing board.


Cutting Instructions

Curry: C- one 6" square D- two 5½" squares Pebble: Le Creme: A- one 6" square B- six 3" squares




Sewing Instructions


1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the A square. Align the A and C squares, right sides together. Sew along both sides of the drawn line with a 1/4" seam allowance. Cut along the drawn line. Makes two half square triangle blocks (HST). Open and press both HSTs. Trim HST units to measure 51/2" × 51/2".




3. Align one B square to the bottom left corner of the same unit. Sew along the drawn line. Press corner towards the B square and trim away excess fabric, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Measures 5½" × 5½".



2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the B squares. trim alway excess fabric, leaving a ¼" seam allowance. Repeat





4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make a matching square unit.





5. Sew the HSTs and square units together in 2 rows. Sew the rows together to complete the Butterfly Block ($10\frac{1}{2}$ " × $10\frac{1}{2}$ "). Press seams as shown.
