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Materials

Fabrics listed are Confetti Cottons by Riley Blake

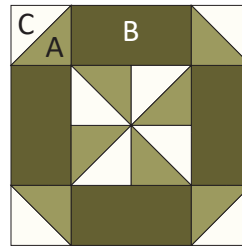
Moss 8" square
Avocado 7" x 15"
Le Creme 8" square

Tools

Marking pencil, scissors, ruler, rotary cutter and mat, iron and ironing board.

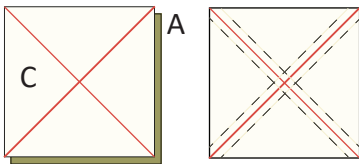
Cutting Instructions

Moss: A- one 7" square
Avocado: B- four 3" x 5½" rectangles
Le Creme: C- one 7" square

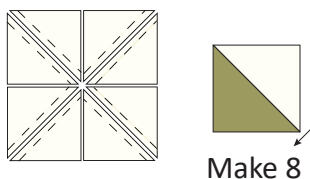


Sewing Instructions

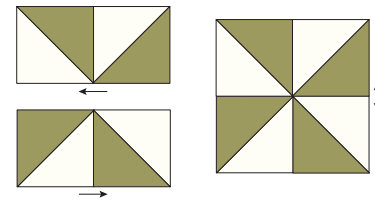
1. Draw a line on both diagonals on the wrong side of the A square.
2. Place the A and C square right sides together. Sew ¼" on each side of the drawn lines.



3. Cut the sewn squares in half vertically and horizontally making 4 equal squares. Cut the squares apart on the diagonal lines making 8 half square triangles (HSTs). Open and press towards the dark fabric. Trim each HST to 3" x 3".



4. Lay out 4 HSTs to create a pinwheel. Sew the HSTs into rows. Press the seams in opposite directions. Sew the rows together to create the pinwheel (5½" x 5½"). Press the seam open.



5. Lay out the remaining 4 HST, 4 B rectangles and the pinwheel in a nine patch. Sew the pieces into rows, pressing as shown. Sew the rows together to complete the Dizzy Pinwheel Block (10½" x 10½").
