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Materials

Fabrics listed are Confetti Cottons by Riley Blake

Cape Verde $6'' \times 9''$ (Updated 5/12)

Tools

Marking pencil, scissors, ruler, rotary cutter and mat, iron and ironing board.

Cutting Instructions


Cape Verde: A- five 2½" squares

Swamp: B- four 3" squares

C- four 2½" squares

Moss: D- four 2½" squares
Le Creme: E- four 3" squares


F- four 2½" squares



Sewing Instructions

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the E squares.

2. Place one E and B square right sides together and sew $\frac{1}{2}$ from the drawn line on each side. Cut the squares apart on the diagonal line. Open and press towards the dark fabric. Trim each square to $2\frac{1}{2}$ " × $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to make 8 half square triangles (HSTs).



3. Lay out the HSTs and A, C, D and F squares as shown. Sew the pieces into rows. Press the seam allowances of the odd rows to the right and even rows to the left. Sew the rows together to complete the Glint Block ($10\frac{1}{2}$ " × $10\frac{1}{2}$ "). Press seams in one direction.
