# Ocean Waves Block 

## Materials

Fabrics listed are Confetti Cottons by Riley Blake
Lodge Pole

## Tools

Marking pencil, scissors, ruler, rotary cutter and mat, iron and ironing board.

## Cutting Instructions

Lodge Pole: A-six $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Cape Verde: B-two $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares
C- two $3^{\prime \prime}$ squares
Le Creme: D-six $312^{\prime \prime}$ squares


## Sewing Instructions

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the A squares and one $D$ square.
2. Place one $D$ and $B$ square right sides together and sew $1 / 4{ }^{\prime \prime}$ from the drawn line on each side. Cut the squares on the diagonal line. Open and press towards the dark fabric. Trim each square to $3^{\prime \prime} \times 3^{\prime \prime}$. You should now have two B/D half square triangle blocks (HST).

3. Repeat the process in Step 2 using $A$ and $D$ squares to make ten A/D HST blocks and $A$ and $B$ squares to make two A/B HST blocks.

4. Sew the HSTs and $C$ squares together in 4 rows. Alternate seam direction when pressing by pressing the first row seams to the right, the second row seams to the left, etc. Then sew the rows together to complete the Ocean Waves Block $\left(101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$. Press seams in one direction.
