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Materials

Pebble 4" x 21"
 Bark 4" x 21"
 Le Creme 6" x WOF

Tools

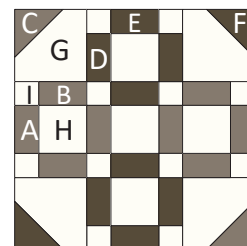
Marking pencil, scissors, ruler, rotary cutter and mat, iron and ironing board.

Cutting Instructions

Pebble: A- one 2½" x 7" rectangle
 B- four 1½" x 2½" rectangles
 C- two 2½" squares

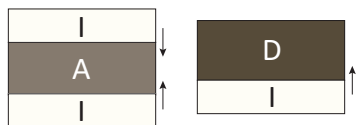
Bark: D- one 2½" x 7" rectangle
 E- four 1½" x 2½" rectangles
 F- two 2½" squares

Le Creme: G- four 3½" squares
 H- five 2½" squares
 I- three 1½" x 7" rectangles



Sewing Instructions

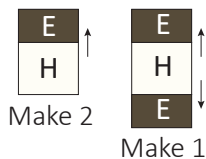
1. Sew the A, D and I rectangles together along the long edges in two strip-sets, I/A/I and D/I as shown.



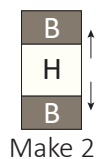
2. Cut the strip-sets into slices 1½" wide, creating 4 slices from each set. Set aside.



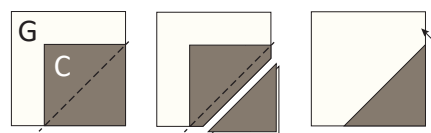
3. Sew an H square to an E rectangle as shown. Make 3. Set 2 aside. Sew an E rectangle to the remaining unit as shown. Set aside.



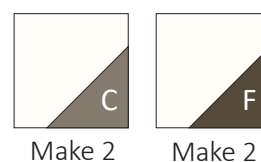
4. Sew a B rectangle to opposite sides of an H square. Make 2. Set aside.



5. Draw a diagonal line on the back of the C and F squares. Place one on top of a G square, right sides together, matching the edges. Sew along the diagonal line. Trim seam allowance to ¼". Press open the corner triangle.



Make a corner triangle on each G square using the C and F squares. You will have 4.



6. Lay out all the elements from each step as shown. Sew together in 4 rows. Sew the rows together to complete the Sugar Candy Block (10½" x 10½"). Press seams as shown.
