

# Block Challenge Quilt

Putting it all together

70" x 90" Finished

## Materials

Fabrics listed are Confetti Cottons (C120) by Riley Blake

Pebble 2½ Yards  
Cloud 3½ Yards

## Tools

Marking pencil, scissors, ruler, rotary cutter and mat, iron and ironing board, 4½" and 10½" Trim-it™ Rulers.

## Cutting Instructions

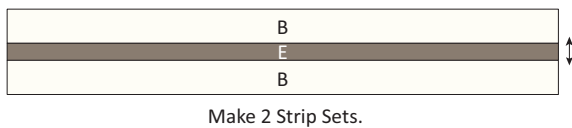
**Pebble:** E- eighteen 2½" x WOF strips  
F- nine 2½" x WOF strips for binding

**Cloud:** A- Cut four 10½" x WOF strips;  
sub-cut fourteen 10½" x WOF squares  
B- four 4½" x WOF strips  
C- Cut four 4½" x WOF strips;  
sub-cut sixty-four 4½" x 2½" rectangles  
D- sixteen 2½" x WOF strips

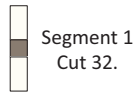
## Sewing Instructions

Refer to the quilt layout for block placement.

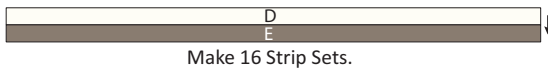
1. Sew 1 E strip between 2 B strips. Press seams towards the B strips. Make 2 strip sets (10½" x WOF).



2. Cut 32- 2½" x 10½" Segment 1.



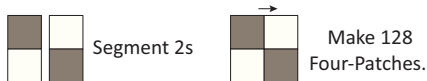
3. Sew 1 D and 1 E strip together. Make 16 strip sets (4½" x WOF).



4. Cut 256- 2½" x 4½" Segment 2.



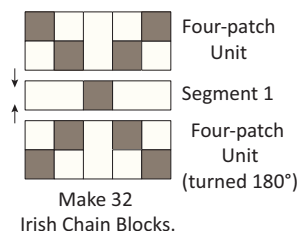
5. Sew together 2 Segment 2s, turning 1 upside down, to make a Four-Patch. Make 128 Four-Patches (4½" square).



6. Sew together 2 Four-Patches with a C rectangle between them to make a Four-patch Unit (10½" x 4½"). Make 64.

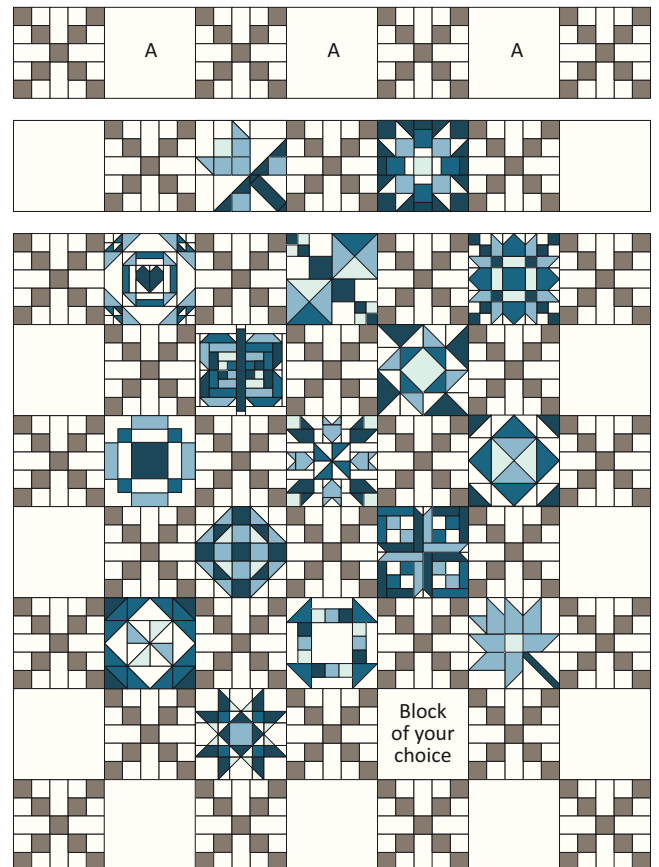


7. Sew together 2 Four-patch Units with a Segment 1 between them, turning one Four-patch Unit 180°, to make an Irish Chain Block (10½" square). Make 32.



8. Arrange Irish Chain, A Blocks, Challenge Blocks, and a Block of your choosing in a 7 x 9 setting. Sew Blocks together in rows. Sew rows together top to bottom.

## Quilt Layout



Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with the F strips. Your quilt is finished! We hope you enjoyed the journey!
