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## Materials

Fabrics listed are Confetti Cottons by Riley Blake

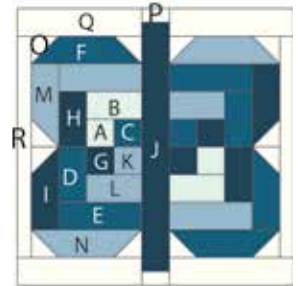
Bleached Denim	2½" x 15"	Cloud	3½" x WOF
Cadet	2½" x WOF	Oxford	2½" x WOF
Cornflower	2½" x WOF		

## Tools

Marking pencil, scissors, ruler, rotary cutter and mat, iron and ironing board.

## Cutting Instructions

<b>Bleached Denim:</b>	A- two 1½" squares	(Oxford continued)	J- one 1½" x 9½" rectangle
	B- two 1½" x 2½" rectangles	<b>Cornflower:</b>	K- one 1½" square
<b>Cadet:</b>	C- two 1½" squares		L- two 1½" x 2½" rectangles
	D- two 1½" x 2½" rectangles		M- three 1½" x 3½" rectangles
	E- three 1½" x 3½" rectangles		N- two 1½" x 4½" rectangles
	F- two 1½" x 4½" rectangles	<b>Cloud:</b>	O- twelve 1½" squares
<b>Oxford:</b>	G- three 1½" squares		P- two 1" x 1½" rectangles
	H- two 1½" x 2½" rectangles		Q- four 1½" x 5" rectangles
	I- two 1½" x 3½" rectangles		R- two 1" x 8½" rectangles



## Sewing Instructions

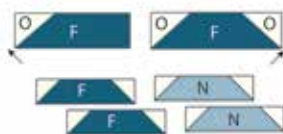
1. Select 2 A, 2 C, 3 G and 1 K squares and sew pairs together as illustrated (1½" x 2½").



2. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the O squares. Place an O square on the top right corner of an E rectangle. Sew along the drawn line. Trim away excess fabric, leaving a ¼" seam allowance. Press. Repeat to make 1 M/O unit (1½" x 3½"). Place an O square on the top left corner of an I rectangle. Sew along the drawn line. Trim away excess fabric, leaving a ¼" seam allowance. Press. Repeat to make 2 I/O units (1½" x 3½").



3. Place an O square on the top left corner of an F rectangle. Sew along the drawn line. Trim away excess fabric, leaving a ¼" seam allowance. Press. Repeat on the top right corner to make 2 F/O units (1½" x 4½"). Repeat this process to make 2 N/O units (1½" x 4½").

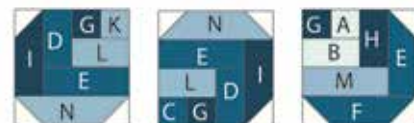


4. The wings of the butterfly are made from four different patchwork blocks. Pay careful attention to fabric placement when assembling each patchwork block.

Layout a B, H and M rectangle, an A/C unit, an F unit and an M unit and sew together as illustrated (4½" x 4½").



Repeat this process with the remaining rectangles and units as illustrated (4½" x 4½").



5. Lay out the units and rectangles as illustrated. Sew units and rectangles together in vertical rows, then sew the columns together. Press to complete the Mosaic Butterfly Block (10½" x 10½").
