On Point Hourglass

Materials

Fabrics listed are Confetti Cottons by Riley Blake

Bleached Denim 7½" x 7½" Cornflower 7½" x 7½" Oxford 4½" x 8"

Cadet 4" x 23"

Cloud 1/8 Yard

Tools

Marking pencil, scissors, ruler, rotary cutter and mat, iron and ironing board.


Cutting Instructions

Bleached Denim: A- one 6½" square Cornflower: B- one 6½" square

C- four 3" x 5½" rectangles Cadet:

Oxford: D- two 3½" squares Cloud: E- two 3½" squares

F- eight 3" squares



Sewing Instructions

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the A squares. Align the A and B squares, right sides together. Sew along both sides of the drawn line with a 1/4" seam allowance. Cut along the drawn line. Makes two half square triangle blocks (HST). Open and press both HSTs.





2. Draw a diagonal line, opposite corners as the seam allowance, on the wrong side of one of the HSTs. Place the two HSTs right sides together and sew 1/4" on each side of the drawn line. Cut along the drawn line for 2 Hourglass blocks. Press the seam allowance open. Find the center at 23/4" and trim to 5½" x 5½". You will only need one of the Hourglass blocks, the other can be added to your stash.





3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the F squares. Place an F piece on the top left corner of a C rectangle and sew on the drawn line. Trim away excess fabric, leaving 1/4" seam allowance. Press. Repeat the process with another F square in the top right corner to complete the Flying Geese unit (3" x 5½"). Repeat to make a total of 4 Flying Geese units.



4. Using the same process as explained in step 1, repeat with the D and E squares to make 4 HSTs and trim units to measure 3" x 3".



5. Lay out pieces and sew as illustrated below. Sew sections into rows. Press to complete the On Point Hourglass block $(10\%" \times 10\%")$.
