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Materials

Fabrics listed are Confetti Cottons by Riley Blake
 Bleached Denim 3" x 9" Cornflower 3½" x WOF
 Cadet 4" x 7" Oxford 3½" x 20"
 Cloud 5" x WOF

Tools

Marking pencil, scissors, ruler, rotary cutter and mat, iron and ironing board.

Cutting Instructions


Cornflower: A - four 2½" squares
 B - eight 1½" squares
Oxford: C - four 2" x 3½" rectangles
 D - four 2" squares
Cadet: E - two 3" squares
Bleached Denim: F - four 2" squares

Cloud: G - four 1½" x 3½" rectangles
 H - two 3" squares
 I - four 2" x 3" rectangles
 J - four 2" squares
 K - four 1½" x 2½" rectangles
 L - four 1½" x 2" rectangles
 M - eight 1½" squares



Sewing Instructions

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 8 B pieces and 8 M pieces. Place an M piece on the top right corner of an A piece and sew on the drawn line. Trim away excess fabric, leaving ¼" seam allowance. Press. Repeat with another M piece in the top left corner (2½" x 2½"). Repeat to make a total of 4 A/M units. Using the same process explained above, repeat with the B and K pieces to make 4 B/K flying geese units (1½" x 2½").



2. Sew one B/K flying geese unit to the bottom of one A/M unit and press (2½" x 3½"). Repeat with the other A/M and B/K units.




3. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the J squares. Place a J square on the top right corner of a C rectangle. Sew along marked line. Trim away excess fabric, leaving a ¼" seam allowance. Press (2" x 3½"). Place another J square on the top left corner of another C rectangle. Sew along the marked line. Trim away excess fabric, leaving ¼" seam allowance. Press (2" x 3½"). Repeat to make 4 sets of C/J units.



4. Repeat step 3 using the D squares and I rectangles to make 4 sets of D/I units (2" x 3").



5. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the H squares. Align the E and H squares, right sides together. Sew along both sides of the drawn line with a ¼" seam allowance. Cut along the drawn line. Makes 2 half square triangle blocks (HST). Open and press both HSTs. Trim HST units to measure 2½" x 2½". Repeat to make a total of 4 HSTs.



6. Lay out pieces and sew as illustrated. Sew sections into rows. Press to complete the Tulip Block (10½" x 10½").
