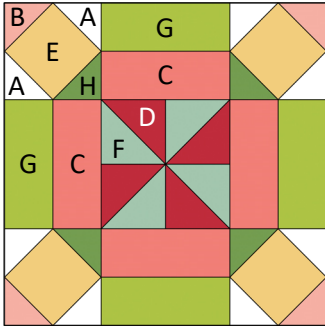

HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE, SNF = STITCH AND FLIP



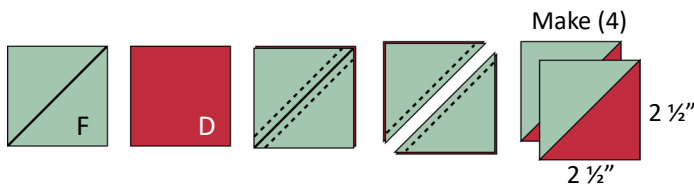
## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

- Fabric 1:**
- A – (8) 2" squares
- Fabric 2:**
- B – (4) 2" squares
- Fabric 3:**
- C – (4) 2" x 4 1/2" rectangles
- Fabric 4:**
- D – (2) 3" squares

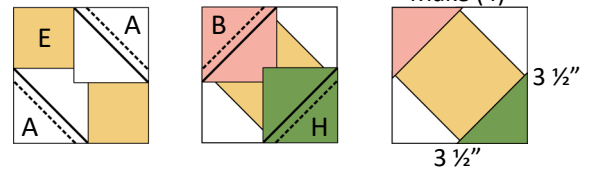
- Fabric 5:**
- E – (4) 3 1/2" squares
- Fabric 6:**
- F – (2) 3" squares

- G – (4) 2" x 4 1/2" rectangles

## SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

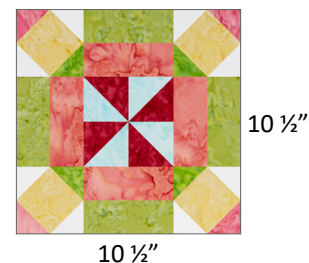
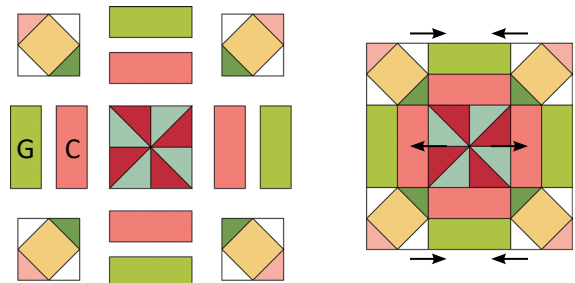
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) F – squares.
2. Place (2) F – squares with (2) D – squares, right sides together. Sew a 1/4" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line on each set of squares. Cut along the drawn diagonal lines, making (4) D/F HST units. Trim HST units to 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" unfinished.



3. Arrange D/F HST units to form a pinwheel unit. Sew together as shown. Pinwheel unit should measure 4 1/2" x 4 1/2" unfinished.
4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) A – squares, (4) B – squares and (4) H – squares.
5. Place (1) A – square onto opposite corners of (4) E – squares, right sides together. Sew along the drawn diagonal lines. Trim excess corner fabric to a 1/4". Press toward the corners.
6. Repeat SNF techniques to attach (1) B – square and (1) H – square to opposite corners of each E – square as shown. SNF units should measure 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" unfinished.



7. Arrange the pinwheel unit, SNF units and remaining cut pieces (C and G) to form Block 7.
8. Sew the block together as shown. Arrows indicate pressing instructions. Once complete, Block 7 should measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" unfinished.
