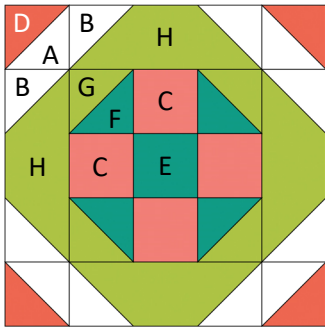

HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE, SNF = STITCH AND FLIP



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 1:

- A – (2) 3" squares
- B – (8) 2 1/2" squares

Fabric 2:

- C – (4) 2 1/2" squares

Fabric 3:

- D – (2) 3" squares

Fabric 4:

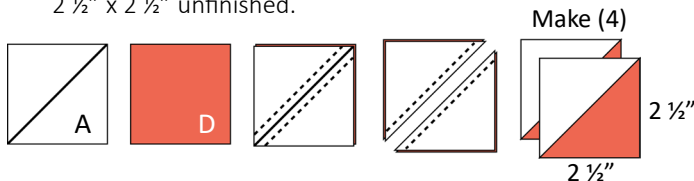
- E – (1) 2 1/2" square
- F – (2) 3" squares

Fabric 5:

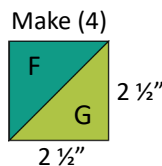
- G – (2) 3" squares
- H – (4) 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

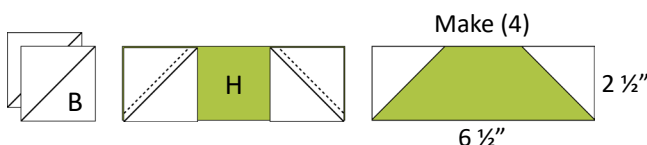
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) A – squares and (2) F – squares. Use the F – squares in Step 3.
2. Place (2) A – squares with (2) D – squares, right sides together. Sew a 1/4" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line on each set of squares. Cut along the drawn diagonal lines, making (4) A/D HST units. Trim HST units to 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" unfinished.



3. Repeat HST unit assembly to make (4) F/G HST units.
4. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) B – squares.

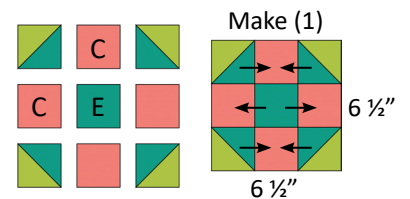


5. Place (1) B – square onto both top corners of (4) H – rectangles, right sides together. Reference diagrams for B – square placement. Sew along the drawn diagonal lines. Trim excess corner fabric to a 1/4". Press toward the corners. B/H SNF units should measure 6 1/2" x 2 1/2" unfinished.



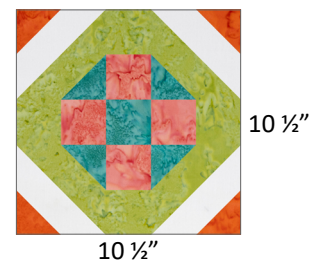
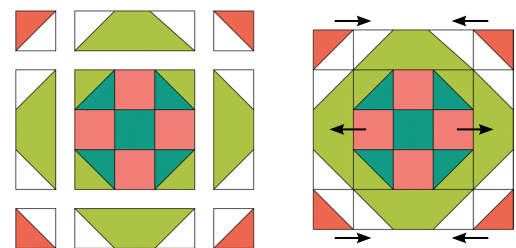
6. Arrange (4) F/G HST units with (4) C – squares and (1) E – square to form the center of Block 12.

7. Sew together as shown. Arrows indicate pressing instructions. The center of Block 12 should measure 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" unfinished.



8. Arrange the remaining HST units, SNF units and the center of Block 12 made in Steps 6-7 to form Block 12.

9. Sew the block together as shown. Arrows indicate pressing instructions. Once complete, Block 12 should measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" unfinished.
