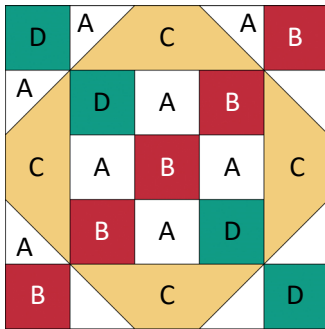

HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE, SNF = STITCH AND FLIP



CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 1:

- A – (12) 2 ½" squares

Fabric 2:

- B – (5) 2 ½" squares

Fabric 3:

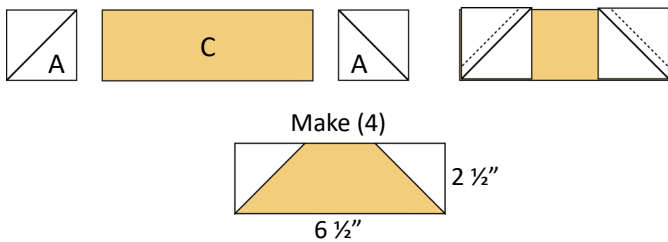
- C – (4) 2 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles

Fabric 4:

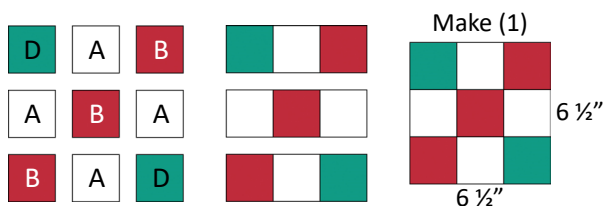
- D – (4) 2 ½" squares

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

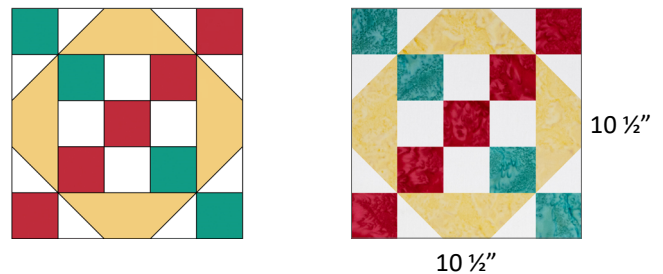
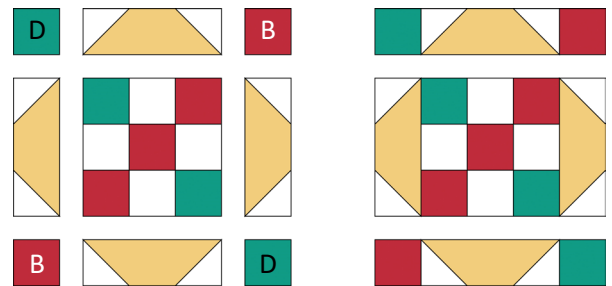
1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) A – squares.
2. Place (1) A – square onto both top corners of (4) C – rectangles, right sides together. Note the orientation of the drawn diagonal lines.
3. Sew along the drawn diagonal lines. Trim excess corner fabric to a ¼". Press toward the corners to make (4) SNF units measuring 6 ½" x 2 ½" unfinished.



4. Arrange (4) A – squares, (3) B – squares and (2) D – squares to form the Block 15 center. Reference the diagram for the placement of each square.
5. Sew together as shown, pressing seams away from Fabric 1. The center of Block 15 should measure 6 ½" x 6 ½" unfinished.



6. Arrange SNF units, the center of Block 15, (2) B – squares and (2) D – squares to form Block 15.
7. Sew the block together as shown, pressing seams away from the SNF units. Once complete, Block 15 should measure 10 ½" x 10 ½" unfinished.
