## Sewing Instructions

SNF = Stitch AND FLIP

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) $E$ - squares,
(2) F - squares, (2) G - squares, (2) H - squares,
(1) K - square, (1) L - square, (1) M - square, and
(1) $N$ - square.
2. Place (2) E-squares onto bottom left corners of
(2) B - rectangles, right sides together. Sew along the drawn diagonal lines. Trim excess corner fabric to $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$. Press toward the corners.
3. Repeat SNF technique to attach (2) $F$ - squares onto bottom right corners of the same $B$ - rectangles to make (2) SNF units measuring $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

4. Repeat SNF technique using remaining B - rectangles, $H$ - squares and $G$ - squares to make (2) SNF units measuring $31 / 4 " \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

5. Arrange (4) C - triangles, (4) I - squares, and (1) J - square as shown. Sew the pieces together in diagonal rows. Press in direction of arrows. Then sew the rows together and press. Add (4) D - triangles to each corner and press to complete block center. Trim the block center to measure $5^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 1:

- $A-(4) 3 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares
- B - (4) $31 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 5^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles
- $C$ - (1) $3 \frac{5}{8 /}$ " square, cut in half diagonally twice*
- $\quad D-(2) 2 \frac{1}{4}$ " squares, cut in half diagonally once*
Fabric 2:
- E - (2) $23 / 4$ " squares

Fabric 3:

- F - (2) $23 / 4$ " squares

Fabric 4:

- $G-(2) 23 / 4 "$ squares Fabric 5:
- $H-(2) 23 / 4 "$ squares

Fabric 6:

- I-(4) 2" squares

Fabric 7:

- J - (1) 2" square


Fabric 8:

- K - (1) $23 / 4$ " square Fabric 9:
- L-(1) $23 / 4$ " square Fabric 10:
- $M-(1) 23 / 4$ " square

Fabric 11:

- $N-(1) 23 / 4$ " square


6. Arrange (4) A - squares,
(4) SNF units, and block center as shown. Sew the pieces together in rows and press. Then sew the rows together and press to make block. The block should measure $101 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ unfinished.
7. Repeat SNF technique to attach (1) K - square,
(1) $L$ - square, (1) $M$ - square, and (1) N - square onto corners of block to complete Block
8. Block 7 should measure $101 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 101 / 2$ " unfinished.
