CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 1:

- A – (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" rectangle
- B – (2) 1 ½" x 5" rectangles

Fabric 2:

- C – (6) 3" x 3" squares

Fabric 3:


- D – (2) 3" x 3" squares

Fabric 4:

- E – (4) 1" x 3" rectangles
- F – (4) 1" x 2 ½" rectangles

Fabric 5:

- G – (8) 3" x 3" squares
- H – (8) 1" x 2 ½" rectangles


RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE


Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS


1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (8) **G**-squares.
2. Layer (1) marked **G**-square on (1) **D**-square, RST. Sew ¼" on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press to make (2) D/G HST units. Repeat to make (4) total units. Trim each HST to 2 ½" x 2 ½".




3. Repeat Step 2 to make (12) C/G HST units as shown below. Trim each HST to 2 ½" x 2 ½".



4. Sew (1) **F**-rectangle to the right side of (1) D/G HST unit as shown below (pay careful attention to the orientation of the HST unit). Next, sew (1) **E**-rectangle to the bottom. Repeat to make (4) total units.



5. Sew (1) **H**-rectangle to the top of (1) C/G HST unit as shown below (pay careful attention to the orientation of the HST unit). Repeat to make (4) total units.



6. Sew (1) **H**-rectangle to the left side of (1) C/G HST unit as shown below (pay careful attention to the orientation of the HST unit). Repeat to make (4) total units.


Make (4)



2 1/2" x 3"


7. Arrange (1) Step 4 unit, (1) Step 5 unit, (1) Step 6 unit, and (1) C/G HST unit as shown below. Sew the units together into pairs. Next, sew the pairs together to make (1) Corner Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.



8. Arrange (4) Corner Units, (2) **B**-rectangles, and (1) **A**-rectangle as shown below. Sew the units and rectangles together into columns. Next, sew the columns together to make Block 10. Block 10 should measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" unfinished.
