CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 1:

- A – (2) 2" x 10" rectangles

Fabric 2:

- B – (12) 2" x 2" squares

Fabric 3:

- C – (2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares

Fabric 4:


- D – (4) 2" x 4 ½" rectangles

Fabric 5:

- E – (1) 4 ½" x 10" rectangle

- F – (1) 4 ½" x 4 ½" square

- G – (2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares



Fabric 6:

- H – (4) 2" x 2" squares

RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER


HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE

SNF = STITCH AND FLIP


Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (12) **B**-squares and (2) **G**-squares.
2. Layer (1) marked **G**-square on (1) **C**-square, RST. Sew ¼" on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press to make (2) HST units. Trim each HST to 2" x 2". Repeat to make (4) total HST units.




3. Align (1) marked **B**-square with the bottom-left and bottom-right corners of (1) **D**-rectangle, RST. Sew on the drawn diagonal lines. Trim excess corner fabric to ¼". Press toward the corners to make (1) B/D SNF unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.




4. Use the SNF method from Step 3 to sew (1) marked **B**-square to each corner of (1) **F**-square to make (1) B/F SNF unit.

5. Arrange (4) HST units, (4) B/D SNF units, and (1) B/F SNF unit as shown below. Sew the units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Center Unit.





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
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6. Sew (2) **A**-rectangles and (1) **E**-rectangle together as shown below to make (1) strip set. Cut the strip set into (4) 2"-wide segments.







7. Arrange (4) **H**-squares, (4) 2"-wide segments, and (1) Center Unit as shown below. Sew the pieces together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make Block 7. Block 7 should measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" unfinished.
