CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 1:


- A – (4) 1 3/4" x 4 1/4" rectangles
- B – (12) 1 3/4" x 3" rectangles
- C – (20) 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" squares

Fabric 2:

- D – (1) 3" x 3" square
- E – (4) 1 3/4" x 3" rectangles
- F – (12) 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" squares

Fabric 3:

- G – (4) 1 3/4" x 3" rectangles
- H – (12) 1 3/4" x 1 3/4" squares




RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

SNF-FG = STITCH AND FLIP FLYING GEESSE


Sew all seams RST and with a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.

SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (12) **C**-squares, (12) **F**-squares, and (12) **H**-squares.
2. Align (1) marked **C**-square with the top-left corner of (1) **E**-rectangle, RST. Sew on the drawn diagonal line. Trim excess corner fabric to 1/4". Press toward the corner. Next, align (1) marked **C**-square with the top-right corner of the same **E**-rectangle, RST. Sew, trim, and press as before to make (1) C/E SNF-FG unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.




3. Repeat Step 2 to make the SNF-FG units shown below, referring to the diagrams for quantity, proper orientation, and placement.




4. Arrange (2) **A**-rectangles, (2) unmarked **C**-squares, and (4) required SNF-FG units as shown, top right. Sew the pieces together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Top Unit. Repeat to make (1) Bottom Unit.


5. Align (1) marked **H**-square with the bottom-left corner of (1) **B**-rectangle, RST. Sew on the drawn diagonal line. Trim excess corner fabric to 1/4". Press toward the corner to make (1) Left Unit. Repeat to make a second unit.

6. Repeat Step 5 to add (1) marked **H**-square to the bottom-right corner of (1) **B**-rectangle to make (1) Right Unit. Repeat to make a second unit.




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
7. Sew (1) C/E SNF-FG unit to the top of (1) B/F SNF-FG unit as shown below. Next, sew (1) Left Unit to the left side and (1) Right Unit to the right side to make (1) Side Unit. Repeat to make a second unit.





8. Arrange (4) unmarked C-squares, (4) B/H SNF-FG units, and (1) D-square as shown below. Sew the squares and units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Center Unit.



9. Sew (1) Side Unit to each side of (1) Center Unit as shown below. Next, sew (1) Top Unit to the top and (1) Bottom Unit to the bottom to make Block 8. Block 8 should measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2" unfinished.
