CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

Fabric 1:

- A – (1) 2 ½" x 12" rectangle

Fabric 2:


- B – (4) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares
- C – (1) 1 ½" x 12" rectangle
- D – (4) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares

Fabric 3:

- E – (1) 6" x 6" square
- F – (5) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares
- G – (4) 1 ½" x 2 ½" rectangles
- H – (4) 1 ½" x 1 ½" squares

Fabric 4:

- I – (1) 6" x 6" square
- J – (1) 1 ½" x 12" rectangle



RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.


SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) **B**-squares. Draw a diagonal line in both directions on the wrong side of (1) **I**-square.
2. Place (1) marked **I**-square on (1) **E**-square, RST. Sew ¼" on each side of both drawn diagonal lines. Cut on the drawn lines and through the vertical and horizontal center to create (8) HST units. Trim each unit to 2 ½" x 2 ½".




3. Sew (1) **H**-square to the top of (1) **D**-square. Next, sew (1) **G**-rectangle to the left side. Repeat to make (4) total units.



4. Align (1) marked **B**-square with the top-left corner of (1) Step 3 unit, RST. Sew on the drawn diagonal line. Trim excess corner fabric to ¼". Press toward the corner. Repeat to make (4) total units.



5. Arrange (1) **F**-square, (2) HST units, and (1) Step 4 unit as shown below. Sew the pieces together into pairs. Next, sew the pairs together to make (1) Corner Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.



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
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6. Sew (1) **A**-rectangle, (1) **C**-rectangle, and (1) **J**-rectangle together to make (1) strip set. Cut the strip set into (4) 2 ½"-wide segments.








7. Arrange (4) Corner Units, (4) 2 ½"-wide segments, and (1) **F**-square as shown below. Sew the pieces together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make Block 9. Block 9 should measure 10 ½" × 10 ½" unfinished.
