### **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

C120-MELLOWROSE (Fabric 1) C120-WEDGEWOOD (Fabric 2) C16956-TULIPS (Fabric 3) C120-GOLDEN (Fabric 4) C120-ROSEMARY (Fabric 5) C120-COLONIAL (Fabric 6) RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE

Sew all seams RST and with a  $\chi''$  seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Measurements in [] indicate unfinished measurements of  $12" \times 12"$  block.






### **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**


This block can be made in two sizes. Cut the pieces for your chosen size as listed below. To make the quilt as shown, sew the  $12" \times 12"$  block.

FABRIC	LABEL	6"×6"	12" × 12"
Fabric 1	Α	(4) 1 ½" × 1 ½" squares	(4) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares
Fabric 2	В	(2) 4" × 4" squares	(2) 6" × 6" squares
Fabric 3	C D	(1) 4" × 4" square (8) 1 ½" × 1 ½" squares	(1) 6" × 6" square (8) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares
Fabric 4	E	(2) 1 ½" × 1 ½" squares	(2) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares
Fabric 5	F	(4) 1 ½" × 1 ½" squares	(4) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares
Fabric 6	G H	(1) 4" × 4" square (2) 1 ½" × 1 ½" squares	(1) 6" × 6" square (2) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares




#### **SEWING INSTRUCTIONS**


- 1. Draw a diagonal line in both directions on the wrong side of (1) **C**–square and (1) **G**–square.
- 2. Place (1) marked **C**–square on (1) **B**–square, RST. Sew ¼" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal lines. Cut along the drawn diagonal lines and through the vertical and horizontal center. Press to make (8) B/C HST units. Trim each unit to measure 1 ½" × 1 ½" [2 ½" × 2 ½"].

3. Repeat Step 2 using (1) marked **G**–square and (1) **B**–square to make (8) B/G HST units. Trim each unit to measure 1 %"  $\times 1 \%$ " [2 %"  $\times 2 \%$ "].


### Make (8)



1 ½" × 1 ½"
[2 ½" × 2 ½"]

4. Arrange (1) F-square, (2) B/C HST units, (2) D-squares, (1) A-square, (2) B/G HST units, and (1) E-square as shown below. Sew the squares and units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Block Quadrant 1 Unit. Repeat to make a second unit.


### Make (2)




3 ½" × 3 ½" [6 ½" × 6 ½"]

Arrange (2) **D**—squares, (2) B/C HST units, (1) **F**—square, (2) B/G HST units, (1) **A**—square, and (1) **H**—square as shown below. Sew the squares and units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Block Quadrant 2 Unit. Repeat to make a second unit.

### Make (2)



3 ½" × 3 ½" [6 ½" × 6 ½"] 6. Arrange (2) Block Quadrant 1 Units and (2) Block Quadrant 2 Units as shown below. Sew the units together into pairs. Next, sew the pairs together to make Block 10. Block 10 should measure 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " | 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " × 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished.
