6" x 6" or 12" x 12" Finished

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FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

C120-MELLOWROSE

(Fabric 1)

C16944-BERRIES

(Fabric 2)

C120-DREAM

(Fabric 3)

C120-GOLDEN

(Fabric 4)

C120-MOSS

(Fabric 5)

C120-CANYONROSE

(Fabric 6)

RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Measurements in [] indicate unfinished measurements of 12" x 12" block.

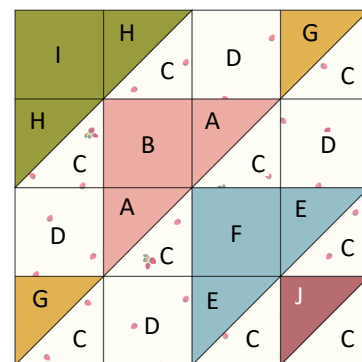


CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

This block can be made in two sizes. Cut the pieces for your chosen size as listed below.

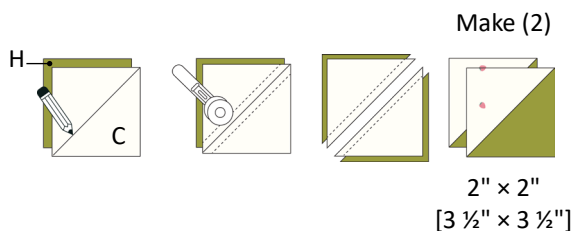
To make the quilt as shown, sew the 12" x 12" block.

FABRIC	LABEL	6" × 6"	12" × 12"
Fabric 1	A	(1) 2 ½" × 2 ½" square	(1) 4" × 4" square
	B	(1) 2" × 2" square	(1) 3 ½" × 3 ½" square
Fabric 2	C	(5) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares	(5) 4" × 4" squares
	D	(4) 2" × 2" squares	(4) 3 ½" × 3 ½" squares
Fabric 3	E	(1) 2 ½" × 2 ½" square	(1) 4" × 4" square
	F	(1) 2" × 2" square	(1) 3 ½" × 3 ½" square
Fabric 4	G	(1) 2 ½" × 2 ½" square	(1) 4" × 4" square
Fabric 5	H	(1) 2 ½" × 2 ½" square	(1) 4" × 4" square
	I	(1) 2" × 2" square	(1) 3 ½" × 3 ½" square
Fabric 6	J	(1) 2 ½" × 2 ½" square	(1) 4" × 4" square



SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (5) **C**-squares.
2. Place (1) marked **C**-square on (1) **H**-square, RST. Sew ¼" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut along the drawn diagonal line and press to make (2) C/H HST units. Trim each unit to measure 2" x 2" [3 ½" x 3 ½"].



3. Repeat Step 2 to make (2) of each HST unit shown below, referring to the diagrams for fabric pairings. Trim each unit to measure 2" x 2" [3 ½" x 3 ½"]. You will only use (1) C/J HST unit.



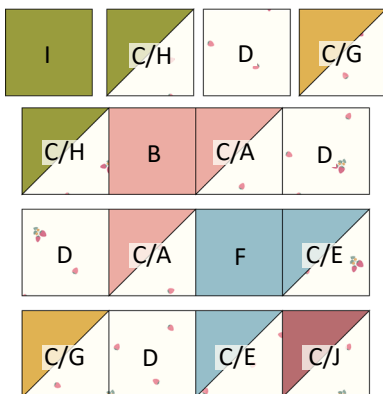
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4. Arrange (1) **I**-square, (9) HST units, (4) **D**-squares, (1) **B**-square, and (1) **F**-square as shown below. Sew the squares and units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make Block 11. Block 11 should measure 6 ½" x 6 ½" [12 ½" x 12 ½"] unfinished.
