

Block 12: Transformed

6" x 6" or 12" x 12" Finished

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FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

C16954-SUMMER

(Fabric 1)

C120-WEDGEWOOD

(Fabric 2)

C120-OXFORDBLUE

(Fabric 3)

RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE

QST = QUARTER SQUARE TRIANGLE

Sew all seams RST and with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Measurements in [] indicate unfinished measurements of 12" x 12" block.

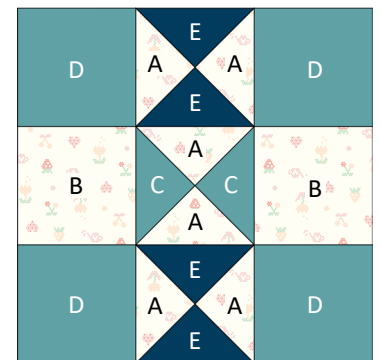


CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

This block can be made in two sizes. Cut the pieces for your chosen size as listed below.

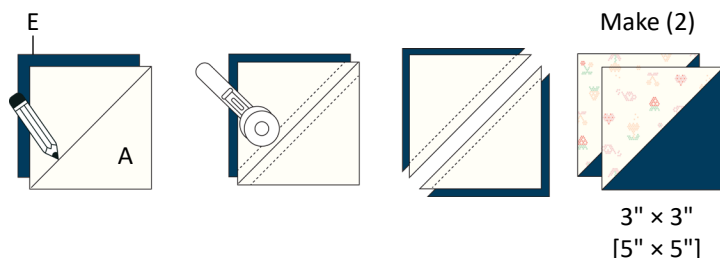
To make the quilt as shown, sew the 12" x 12" block.

Fabric 1	A	(2) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares	(2) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
	B	(2) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares	(2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
Fabric 2	C	(1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square	(1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square
	D	(4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares	(4) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
Fabric 3	E	(1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square	(1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square

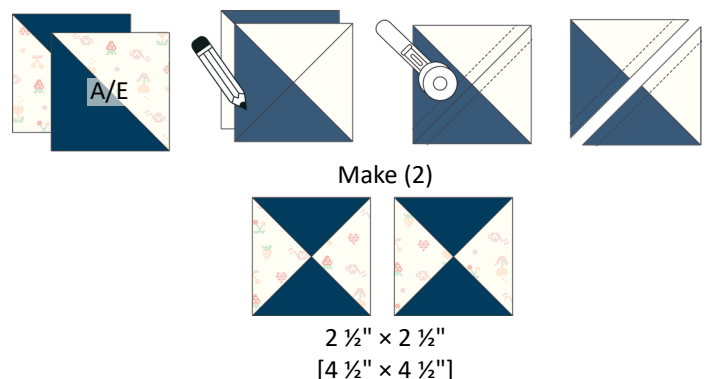


SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) **A**-squares.
2. Place (1) marked **A**-square on (1) **E**-square, RST. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut along the drawn diagonal line and press to make (2) A/E HST units. Trim each unit to measure 3" x 3" [5" x 5"].



3. Place (2) A/E HST units RST, with the A halves facing the E halves. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (1) HST, so the drawn line is perpendicular to the HST seam to create an "X" with the HST seam. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut along the drawn diagonal line and press to make (2) A/E QST units. Trim each unit to measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " [$4\frac{1}{2}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ "].



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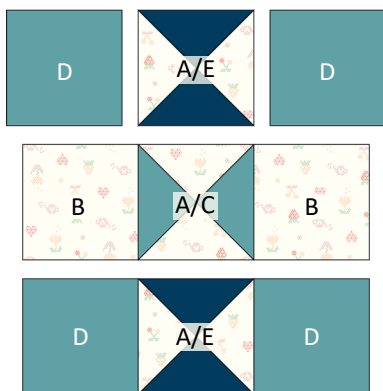
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4. Repeat steps 2-3 using (1) marked **A**-square and (1) **C**-square to make (2) A/C QST units. Trim each unit to measure 2 ½" × 2 ½" [4 ½" × 4 ½"]. You will only use (1) A/C QST unit.



5. Arrange (4) **D**-squares, (2) A/E QST units, (2) **B**-squares, and (1) A/C QST unit as shown below. Sew the squares and units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make Block 12. Block 12 should measure 6 ½" × 6 ½" [12 ½" × 12 ½"] unfinished.
