

Block 2: Haven

6" x 6" or 12" x 12" Finished

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FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

C16943-LOVE

(Fabric 1)

C120-CANYONROSE

(Fabric 2)

C120-CHIVE

(Fabric 3)

RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

FG = FLYING GEESSE

HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Measurements in [] indicate unfinished measurements of 12" x 12" block.

Confetti COTTON SOLIDS

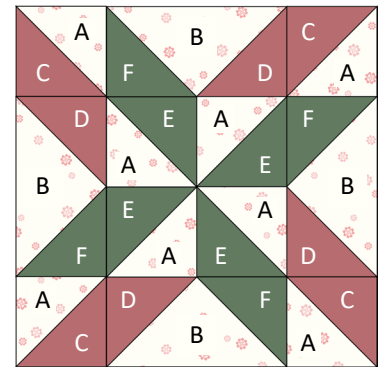


CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS

This block can be made in two sizes. Cut the pieces for your chosen size as listed below.

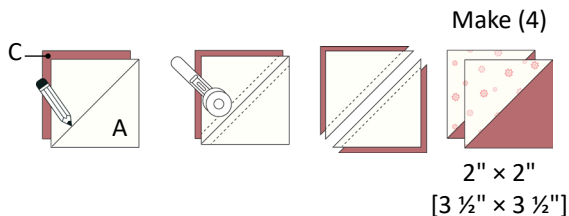
To make the quilt as shown, sew both the 6" x 6" and 12" x 12" blocks.

FABRIC	LABEL	6" x 6"	12" x 12"
Fabric 1	A	(4) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares	(4) 4" x 4" squares
	B	(4) 2" x 3 ½" rectangles	(4) 3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangles
Fabric 2	C	(2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares	(2) 4" x 4" squares
	D	(4) 2" x 2" squares	(4) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares
Fabric 3	E	(2) 2 ½" x 2 ½" squares	(2) 4" x 4" squares
	F	(4) 2" x 2" squares	(4) 3 ½" x 3 ½" squares



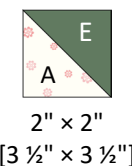
SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) **A**-squares, (4) **D**-squares, and (4) **F**-squares.
2. Place (1) marked **A**-square on (1) **C**-square, RST. Sew ¼" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut along the drawn diagonal line and press to make (2) HST units. Trim each unit to measure 2" x 2" [3 ½" x 3 ½"]. Repeat to make (4) total A/C HST units.

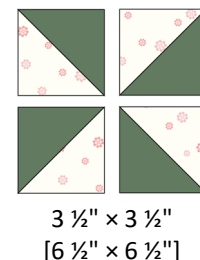


3. Repeat Step 2 using marked **A**-squares and **E**-squares to make (4) total A/E HST units.

4. Arrange (4) A/E HST units as shown below. Sew the units together in pairs. Next, sew the pairs together to make (1) Center Unit.



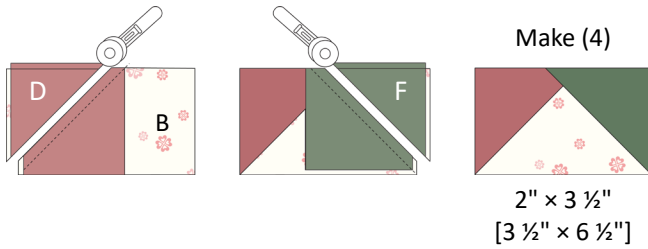
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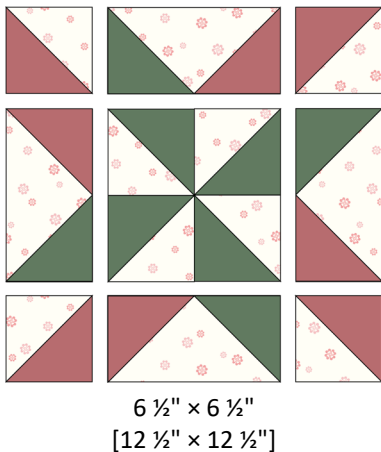
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5. Align (1) marked **D**-square with the top left corner of (1) **B**-rectangle, RST. Sew on the drawn diagonal line. Trim excess corner fabric to $\frac{1}{4}$ ". Press toward the corner. Next, align (1) marked **F**-square with the top right corner of the same **B**-rectangle, RST. Sew, trim, and press as before to make (1) FG unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.



6. Arrange (4) A/C HST units, (4) FG units, and (1) Center Unit as shown below. Sew the units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make Block 2. Block 2 should measure 6 ½" × 6 ½" [12 ½" × 12 ½"] unfinished.
