6" × 6" or 12" × 12" Finished

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

C16943-LOVE (Fabric 1) C120-CANYONROSE (Fabric 2) C120-CHIVE (Fabric 3) RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

FG = FLYING GEESE

HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Measurements in [] indicate unfinished measurements of 12" × 12" block.








CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS


This block can be made in two sizes. Cut the pieces for your chosen size as listed below. To make the quilt as shown, sew both the $6" \times 6"$ and $12" \times 12"$ blocks.

FABRIC	LABEL	6" × 6"	12" × 12"
Fabric 1	A	(4) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares	(4) 4" × 4" squares
	B	(4) 2" × 3 ½" rectangles	(4) 3 ½" × 6 ½" rectangles
Fabric 2	C	(2) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares	(2) 4" × 4" squares
	D	(4) 2" × 2" squares	(4) 3 ½" × 3 ½" squares
Fabric 3	E	(2) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares	(2) 4" × 4" squares
	F	(4) 2" × 2" squares	(4) 3 ½" × 3 ½" squares



SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) A-squares,
 D-squares, and (4) F-squares.
- 2. Place (1) marked **A**–square on (1) **C**–square, RST. Sew ¼" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut along the drawn diagonal line and press to make (2) HST units. Trim each unit to measure 2" \times 2" [3 ½" \times 3 ½"]. Repeat to make (4) total A/C HST units.



3. Repeat Step 2 using marked **A**–squares and **E**–squares to make (4) total A/E HST units.

Make (4)



2" × 2" [3 ½" × 3 ½"]

4. Arrange (4) A/E HST units as shown below. Sew the units together in pairs. Next, sew the pairs together to make (1) Center Unit.



3 ½" × 3 ½" [6 ½" × 6 ½"]




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6" × 6" or 12" × 12" Finished

5. Align (1) marked **D**—square with the top left corner of (1) **B**—rectangle, RST. Sew on the drawn diagonal line. Trim excess corner fabric to ¼". Press toward the corner. Next, align (1) marked **F**—square with the top right corner of the same **B**—rectangle, RST. Sew, trim, and press as before to make (1) FG unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.








2" × 3 ½" [3 ½" × 6 ½"]

6. Arrange (4) A/C HST units, (4) FG units, and (1) Center Unit as shown below. Sew the units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make Block 2. Block 2 should measure 6 %" $\times 6 \%$ " [12 %" \times 12 %"] unfinished.



6 ½" × 6 ½" [12 ½" × 12 ½"]
