RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER

FG = FLYING GEESE

HST = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes.








CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS


This block can be made in two sizes, each with a different set of instructions. Cut the pieces for the $6" \times 6"$ as listed below. To make the quilt as shown, sew the $12" \times 12"$ block following the instructions on page 3.

FABRIC	LABEL	6" × 6"
Fabric 1	A B	(2) 2" × 2" squares (8) 1 ½" × 1 ½" squares
Fabric 2	C D E F	(1) 2 ½" × 2 ½" square (4) 1 ½" × 2 ½" rectangles (4) 1" × 2" rectangles (4) 1" × 1 ½" rectangles
Fabric 3	G H	(4) 1" × 2 ½" rectangles (4) 1" × 2" rectangles
Fabric 4	l J	(2) 2" × 2" squares (8) 1 ½" × 1 ½" squares




SEWING INSTRUCTIONS

- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (2) A-squares,
 B-squares, and (4) J-squares.
- 2. Place (1) marked **A**–square on (1) **I**–square, RST. Sew %" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut along the drawn diagonal line and press to make (2) HST units. Trim each unit to measure 1%" $\times 1\%$ ". Repeat to make (4) total units.



Sew (1) F-rectangle to the top of (1) HST unit as shown below, paying careful attention to the orientation of the HST unit. Next, sew (1) E-rectangle to the left side. In the same manner, sew (1) H-rectangle to the top and (1) G-rectangle to the left side to make (1) Corner Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.






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


4. Align (1) marked **J**-square with the top left corner of (1) **D**-rectangle, RST. Sew on the drawn diagonal line. Trim excess corner fabric to ¼". Press toward the corner. Next, align (1) marked **B**-square with the top right corner of the same **D**-rectangle, RST. Sew, trim, and press as before to make (1) FG unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.




5. Sew (1) unmarked **B**-square and (1) unmarked **J**-square together as shown below. Next, sew (1) FG unit to the top to make (1) Side Unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.



6. Arrange (4) Corner Units, (4) Side Units, and (1) **C**-square as shown below. Sew the units and square together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make Block 4. Block 4 should measure 6 ½" × 6 ½" unfinished.






CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS


This block can be made in two sizes, each with a different set of instructions. Cut the pieces for the 12" \times 12" as listed below. To make the quilt as shown, sew the 12" \times 12" block. To make the 6" \times 6" block, follow the instructions on page 1.

FABRIC	LABEL	12" × 12"
Fabric 1	A B	(4) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares (4) 2" × 2" squares
Fabric 2	C D E F G	(1) 3 ½" × 3 ½" square (4) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares (8) 2" × 3 ½" rectangles (12) 2" × 2" squares (4) 1 ½" × 2 ¾" rectangles (4) 1 ½" × 2" rectangles
Fabric 3	I J K L	(4) 2" × 3 ½" rectangles (16) 2" × 2" squares (4) 1 ½" × 3 ½" rectangles (4) 1 ½" × 2 ¾" rectangles
Fabric 4	M N	(4) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares (4) 2" × 2" squares




SEWING INSTRUCTIONS


- Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (4) A-squares,
 F-squares, (16) J-squares, and (2) M-squares.
- Place (1) marked A-square on (1) unmarked M-square, RST. Sew ¼" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut along the drawn diagonal line and press to make (2) A/M HST units. Trim each unit to measure 2" × 2". Repeat to make (4) total units.



3. Repeat Step 2 to make (4) of each HST unit shown below, referring to the diagrams for fabric pairings. Trim each unit to measure $2" \times 2"$.



- 4. Sew (1) H-rectangle to the top of (1) A/M HST unit as shown below, paying careful attention to the orientation of the HST unit. Next, sew (1) G-rectangle to the left side. In the same manner, sew (1) L-rectangle to the top and (1) K-rectangle to the left side to make (1) Corner Unit 1. Repeat to make (2) total units.
- 5. Repeat Step 4, rotating the A/M HST unit as shown below to make (2) Corner Unit 2s.


6. Align (1) marked F-square with the top left corner of (1) I-rectangle, RST. Sew on the drawn diagonal line. Trim excess corner fabric to ¼". Press toward the corner. Next, align (1) marked F-square with the top right corner of the same I-rectangle, RST. Sew, trim, and press as before to make (1) F/I FG unit. Repeat to make (4) total units.




7. Repeat Step 6 using marked **J**–squares and **E**–rectangles to make (8) total E/J FG units.




8. Arrange (2) A/D HST units, (1) F/I FG unit, (2) **B**-squares, and (1) E/J FG unit as shown below, paying careful attention to the orientation of the HST and FG units. Sew the units and squares together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Top Unit. Repeat to make (1) Bottom Unit.




9. Arrange (2) D/M HST units, (1) E/J FG unit, (2) **N**-squares, and (1) F/I FG unit as shown below, paying careful attention to the orientation of the HST and FG units. Sew the units and squares together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Side Unit. Repeat to make a second Side Unit.



10. Arrange (4) unmarked **F**-squares, (4) E/J FG units, and (1) **C**-square as shown below. Sew the squares and units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Center Unit.



11. Arrange (2) Corner Unit 1s, (2) Corner Unit 2s, (1) Top Unit, (2) Side Units, (1) Center Unit, and (1) Bottom Unit as shown below, paying careful attention to the orientation of each unit. Sew the units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make Block 4. Block 4 should measure 12 ½" × 12 ½" unfinished.
