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**FABRIC REQUIREMENTS** 

C120-MELLOWROSE

(Fabric 1)

C120-WEDGEWOOD

(Fabric 2)

C120-DREAM

(Fabric 3)

C120-GOLDEN

(Fabric 4)

C120-MARSALA

(Fabric 5)

C120-MOSS (Fabric 6)

C120-COLONIAL

(Fabric 7)

C16951-STITCHED

(Fabric 8)

C120-CAPEVERDE

(Fabric 9)

C120-ROSEMARY

(Fabric 10) C120-SANGRIA

(Fabric 11)

**RST** = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER **HST** = HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE

Sew all seams RST and with a 1/4" seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Measurements in [] indicate unfinished measurements of 12"  $\times$  12" block.






#### **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

This block can be made in two sizes. Cut the pieces for your chosen size as listed below. To make the quilt as shown, sew both the  $6" \times 6"$  and  $12" \times 12"$  blocks.

Fabric 4	D	(1) 2 ½" × 2 ½" square	(1) 4" × 4" square
Fabric 5	Е	(1) 2 ½" × 2 ½" square	(1) 4" × 4" square
Fabric 6	F	(1) 4 ½" × 4 ½" square*	(1) 7 ½" × 7 ½" square*
Fabric 7	G	(1) 2 ½" × 2 ½" square	(1) 4" × 4" square
Fabric 8	Н	(6) 2 ½" × 2 ½" squares	(6) 4" × 4" squares
Fabric 9	I	(1) 4 ½" × 4 ½" square*	(1) 7 ½" × 7 ½" square*
Fabric 10	J	(1) 2 ½" × 2 ½" square	(1) 4" × 4" square
Fabric 11	K	(1) 2 ½" × 2 ½" square	(1) 4" × 4" square




<sup>\*</sup>Cut the square in half diagonally twice to make (4) triangles. You will use one.

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#### **SEWING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (6) **H**–squares.
- 2. Place (1) marked **H**–square on (1) **D**–square, RST. Sew ¼" away from both sides of the drawn diagonal line. Cut along the drawn diagonal line and press to make (2) H/D HST units. Trim each unit to measure  $2" \times 2" [3 \%" \times 3 \%"]$ .



3. Repeat Step 2 to make (2) of each HST unit shown below, referring to the diagrams for fabrics pairings. Trim each unit to measure  $2" \times 2" [3 \%" \times 3 \%"]$ .











4. Sew (1) H/K HST unit and (1) H/J HST unit together as shown below to make (1) Side Unit. Repeat to make (4) units total, referring to the diagrams for HST pairings.







2" × 3 ½" [3 ½" × 6 ½"]








5. Arrange (1) A-triangle, (1) C-triangle (1) F-triangle, and (1) I-triangle as shown below. Sew the triangles together into pairs. Next, sew the pairs together to make (1) Center Unit. Trim the unit to measure  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " [ $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " ×  $6 \frac{1}{2}$ "] if needed.



6. Arrange (4) remaining HST units, (4) Side Units, and (1) Center Unit as shown below. Sew the units together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make Block 6. Block 6 should measure 6 ½" × 6 ½" [12 ½" × 12 ½"] unfinished.
