# **Block 7: Just Keep Stitching**

6" × 6" or 12" × 12" Finished

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#### **FABRIC REQUIREMENTS**

C120-CHAMPAGNEPINK (Fabric 1) C120-MINK (Fabric 2) C16941-PLUMERIA (Fabric 3) C120-DREAM (Fabric 4) C120-GOLDEN (Fabric 5) C120-WEDGEWOOD (Fabric 6) RST = RIGHT SIDES TOGETHER
SNF = STITCH AND FLIP

Sew all seams RST and with a ¼" seam allowance. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Measurements in [] indicate unfinished measurements of 12" × 12" block.








#### **CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS**

This block can be made in two sizes. Cut the pieces for your chosen size as listed below. To make the quilt as shown, sew the  $12" \times 12"$  block.

Fabric 1	A B	(1) 1" × 2" rectangle (1) 1" × 1" square	(1) 1 ½" × 3 ½" rectangle (1) 1 ½" × 1 ½" square
Fabric 2	С	(1) ¾" × 1" rectangle	(1) 1" × 1 ½" rectangle
Fabric 3	D E F G H I J	(1) 2 ½" × 2 ½" square (1) 1 ½" × 4 ½" rectangle (1) 1 ½" × 2" rectangle (1) 1" × 4 ½" rectangle (2) 1" × 2" rectangles (2) 1" × 1 ½" rectangles (4) 1" × 1" squares (1) ¾" × 1" rectangle	(1) 4 ½" × 4 ½" square (1) 2 ½" × 8 ½" rectangle (1) 2 ½" × 3 ½" rectangle (1) 1 ½" × 8 ½" rectangle (2) 1 ½" × 3 ½" rectangles (2) 1 ½" × 2 ½" rectangles (4) 1 ½" × 1 ½" squares (1) 1" × 1 ½" rectangle
Fabric 4	L M N O	(1) 2 ½" × 2 ½" square (2) 2" × 2" squares (2) 1 ½" × 2" rectangles (2) 1" × 2" rectangles (2) 1" × 1" squares	(1) 4 ½" × 4 ½" square (2) 3 ½" × 3 ½" squares (2) 2 ½" × 3 ½" rectangles (2) 1 ½" × 3 ½" rectangles (2) 1 ½" × 1 ½" squares
Fabric 5	Q	(1) 1" × 1 ½" rectangle	(1) 1 ½" × 2 ½" rectangle
Fabric 6	R S	(1) 1 ½" × 6 ½" rectangle (1) 1" × 1 ½" rectangle	(1) 2 ½" × 12 ½" rectangle (1) 1 ½" × 2 ½" rectangle




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
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#### **SEWING INSTRUCTIONS**

- 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of (3) **J**–squares.
- 2. Align (1) marked **J**–square with the top left corner of (1) **N**–rectangle, RST. Sew on the drawn diagonal line. Trim excess corner fabric to ¼". Press toward the corner to make (1) J/N SNF unit.



3. Gather the required pieces and use the SNF method from Step 2 to make (1) of each unit shown below, referencing the diagrams for proper placement and orientation.



4. Sew (2) **P**-squares and (1) **B**-square together as shown below.




5. Sew (1) **C**-rectangle and (1) **K**-rectangle together as shown below.




6. Sew (1) unmarked **J**-square to the bottom of the Step 5 unit as shown below. Next, sew (1) **I**-rectangle to each side to make (1) Needle Unit.



7. Sew (1) J/N SNF unit, the Step 4 unit, (1) J/M SNF unit, and (1) Needle Unit together as shown below to make (1) Sewing Machine Left Unit.



8. Sew (2) **O**-rectangles and (1) **A**-rectangle together as shown below. Next, sew (1) J/N Reversed SNF unit to the top and (1) **M**-square to the bottom to make (1) Sewing Machine Right Unit.




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
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
9. Sew (1) **L**-square and (1) **D**-square together as shown below. Next, sew (1) Sewing Machine Left Unit to the left side and (1) Sewing Machine Right Unit to the right side to make (1) Sewing Machine Body Unit.




10. Sew (1) **E**-rectangle, (1) **Q**-rectangle, and (1) **F**-rectangle together as shown below to make (1) Thread Unit.



11. Sew (2) **H**-rectangles and (1) **S**-rectangle together as shown below to make (1) Wheel Unit.



12. Sew (1) **G**-rectangle to the left side and (1) Wheel Unit to the right side of (1) Sewing Machine Body Unit as shown below. Next, sew (1) Thread Unit to the top and (1) **R**-rectangle to the bottom to make Block 7. Block 7 should measure 6 ½" × 6 ½" [12 ½" × 12 ½"] unfinished.
