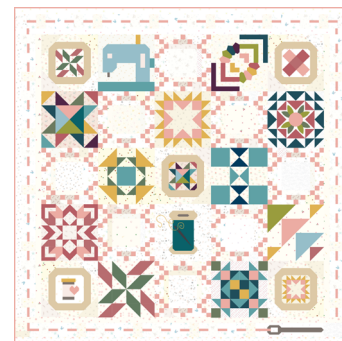

CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS



C120-BISCUIT

Cut (5) 2" x WOF strips. Label as A.
Cut (20) 1" x 1" squares. Label as B.



C120-MELLOWROSE

Cut (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Set aside for binding.
Cut (10) 1 1/2" x 34" strips. Label as C.
Cut (2) 1 1/2" x 26" strips. Label as D.
Cut (4) 1" x 38" strips. Label as E.
Cut (1) 1" x 3" rectangle. Label as F.
Cut (1) 1" x 2 1/4" rectangle. Label as G.
Cut (2) 1" x 1 3/4" rectangles. Label as H.
Cut (1) 1" x 1 1/4" rectangle. Label as I.



C120-MINK

Cut (1) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangle. Label as J.
Cut (1) 1 1/4" x 2 1/2" rectangle. Label as K.
Cut (2) 1 1/4" x 1 1/4" squares. Label as L.
Cut (2) 1" x 2" rectangles. Label as M.



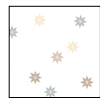

Cut (19) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles. Label as N.
Cut (2) 2" x 34" strips. Label as O.



C16941-PLUMERIA

Cut (2) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:
(1) 1 3/4" x 60 1/2" strip. Label as P.



C16942-STARS

Cut (1) 2 1/2" x 34" strip. Label as Q.
Cut (2) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:
(1) 1 3/4" x 60 1/2" strip. Label as R.
Cut (2) 1 1/2" x 34" strips. Label as S.



C16943-LOVE

Cut (2) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:
(1) 1 3/4" x 71 1/2" strip. Label as T.



C16944-BERRIES

Cut (2) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:
(1) 1 3/4" x 60 1/2" strip. Label as U.



C16945-CROSS

Cut (2) 2" x 2" squares. Label as V.
Cut (2) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:
(1) 1 3/4" x 65 1/2" strip. Label as W.
(4) 1 3/4" x 3" rectangles. Label as X.
Cut (2) 1 1/2" x 9 1/2" rectangles. Label as Y.
Cut (1) 1 1/2" x 2" rectangle. Label as Z.
Cut (4) 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" squares. Label as AA.
Cut (2) 1" x 3 1/2" rectangles. Label as BB.



C16946-FRENCHIE

Cut (19) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles. Label as CC.



C16948-PRESSERS

Cut (1) 4 1/2" x 34" strip. Label as DD.
Cut (2) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:
(1) 1 3/4" x 71 1/2" strip. Label as EE.



C16949-FORAGING

Cut (2) 3" x 3 1/2" rectangles. Label as FF.

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C16950-SKIES

Cut (1) 3 1/2" x 6" rectangle. Label as GG.



C16953-CHARMS

Cut (2) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(1) 1 3/4" x 60 1/2" strip. Label as HH.



C16954-SUMMER

Cut (2) 2 1/2" x 26" strips. Label as II.

Cut (1) 2 1/4" x 3" rectangle. Label as JJ.

Cut (5) 2" x WOF strips. Label as KK.



C16955-BOXED

Cut (1) 1 3/4" x 3 1/2" rectangle. Label as LL.



C16957-STARS

Cut (8) 1 3/4" x 38" strips. Label as MM.



C16958-DRAGONFLIES

Cut (20) 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" rectangles. Label as NN.



C16959-SUNNY

Cut (2) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Piece together end-to-end; subcut:

(1) 1 3/4" x 71 1/2" strip. Label as OO.

Cut (3) 1 1/2" x 34" strips. Label as PP.



C16960-DITSY

Cut (1) 2 1/2" x 34" strip. Label as QQ.



FROM REMAINDER OF ALL (21) HUSH HUSH FABRICS

Cut (8) 6 1/2" x 6 1/2" squares. Label as RR.

Cut (20) 5" x 5" squares. Label as SS.

Cut (32) 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" squares. Label as TT.

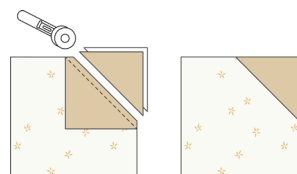
Cut (32) 1 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles. Label as UU.

SEWING TECHNIQUES

Sew all seams RST and with a 1/4" seam allowance unless stated otherwise. Refer to the Quilt Layout Diagram for placement of the prints. Press seams as desired unless stated otherwise. Dimensions listed in steps are unfinished sizes. Please refer to the following general sewing technique as this method is referenced throughout the pattern in its abbreviated form.

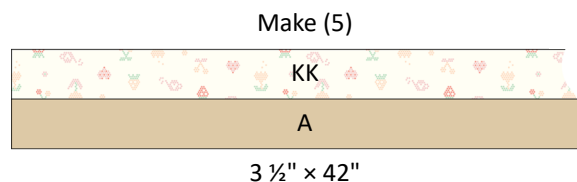
STITCH AND FLIP METHOD (SNF)

Place (2) pieces RST, matching raw edges in the corner to be replaced. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of the smaller piece across the corner. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the seam allowance outside the sewn line to 1/4". Flip the smaller piece away from the larger piece and press, replacing the corner. The size of the larger, original piece does not change.

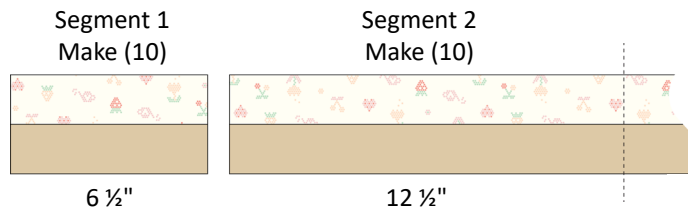


STRIP SET ASSEMBLY

1. Sew (1) **KK**-strip and (1) **A**-strip together to make (1) strip set. Repeat to make (5) strip sets.



2. Cut each strip set into (2) 6 1/2"-wide segments and (2) 12 1/2"-wide segments to make a total of (10) 6 1/2"-wide segments (label as Segment 1) and (10) 12 1/2"-wide segments (label as Segment 2).

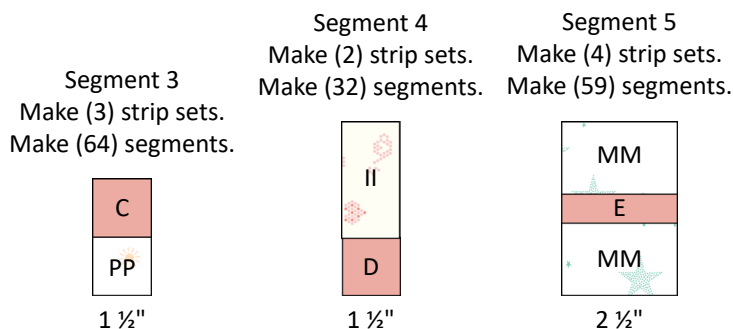


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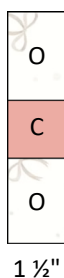

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3. Repeat steps 1-2 to make the strip set segments shown below, paying close attention to the order of strips. Label as noted.

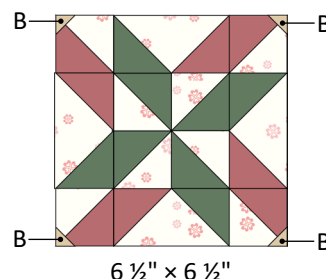

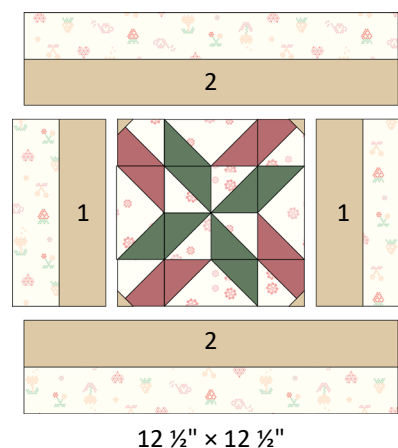


FRAMED BLOCK ASSEMBLY

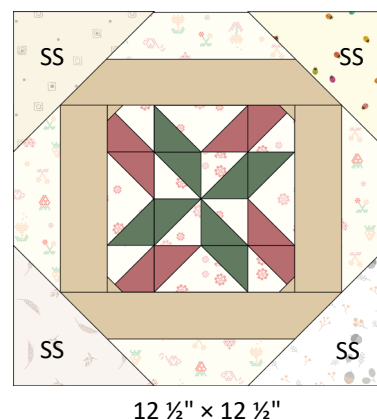
4. Use the SNF method to sew (1) **B**-square to each corner of (1) 6" Block 2 as shown below to make (1) Block Center.



5. Sew (1) Segment 1 to each side of (1) Block Center. Next, sew (1) Segment 2 to the top and bottom to make (1) Block Unit. (The C120-BISCUIT side of each segment should be sewn to the Block Center.)



6. Use the SNF method to sew (1) **SS**-square to each corner of (1) Block Unit as shown below to make (1) Framed Block.



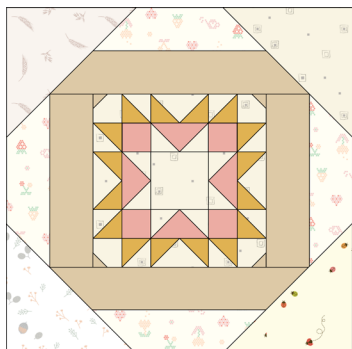
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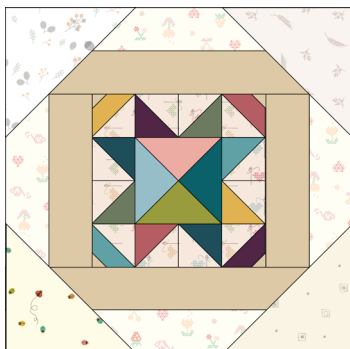
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7. Repeat steps 4-6 to make (4) additional Framed Blocks, referring to the diagrams below for the required 6" Blocks.

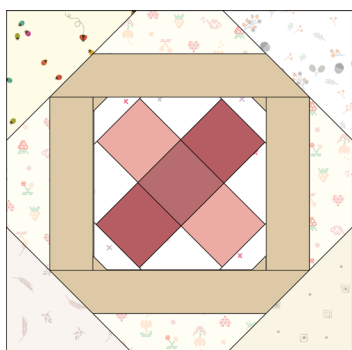

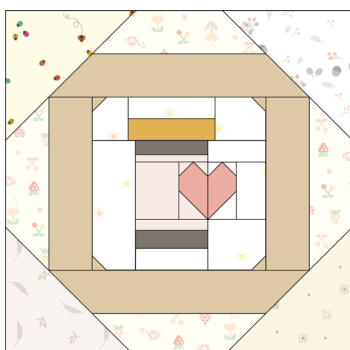

PIECED BLOCK ASSEMBLY

8. Sew (2) Segment 3s together as shown below to make (1) Four-Patch Unit. Repeat to make (32) total units.

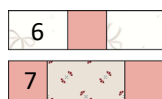

9. Sew (1) Segment 6 and (1) Segment 7 together as shown below to make (1) Pieced Unit. Repeat to make (16) total units.

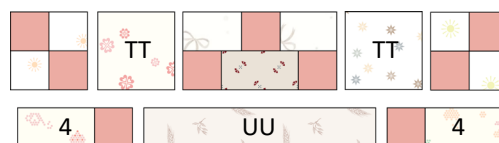

10. Arrange (2) Four-Patch Units, (2) **TT**-squares, (1) Pieced Unit, (2) Segment 4s, and (1) **UU**-rectangle as shown below. Sew the units and pieces together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Top/Bottom Unit. Repeat to make (16) total units.

11. Sew (1) Segment 8, (1) Segment 9, and (1) **UU**-rectangle together as shown below to make (1) Side Unit. Repeat to make (16) total units.

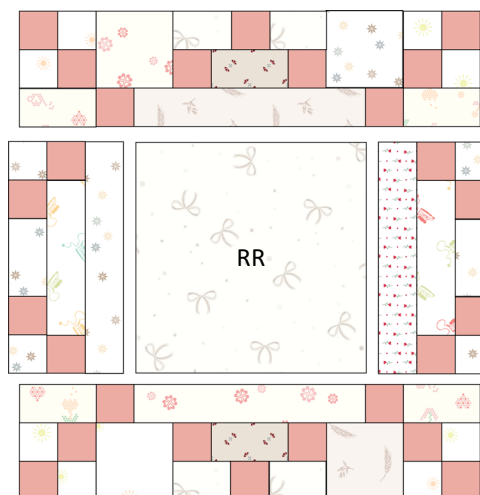

12. Sew (1) Side Unit to each side of (1) **RR**-square as shown below. Next, sew (1) Top/Bottom Unit to the top and bottom to make (1) Pieced Block. Pay careful attention to the orientation of each unit. Repeat to make (8) total blocks.

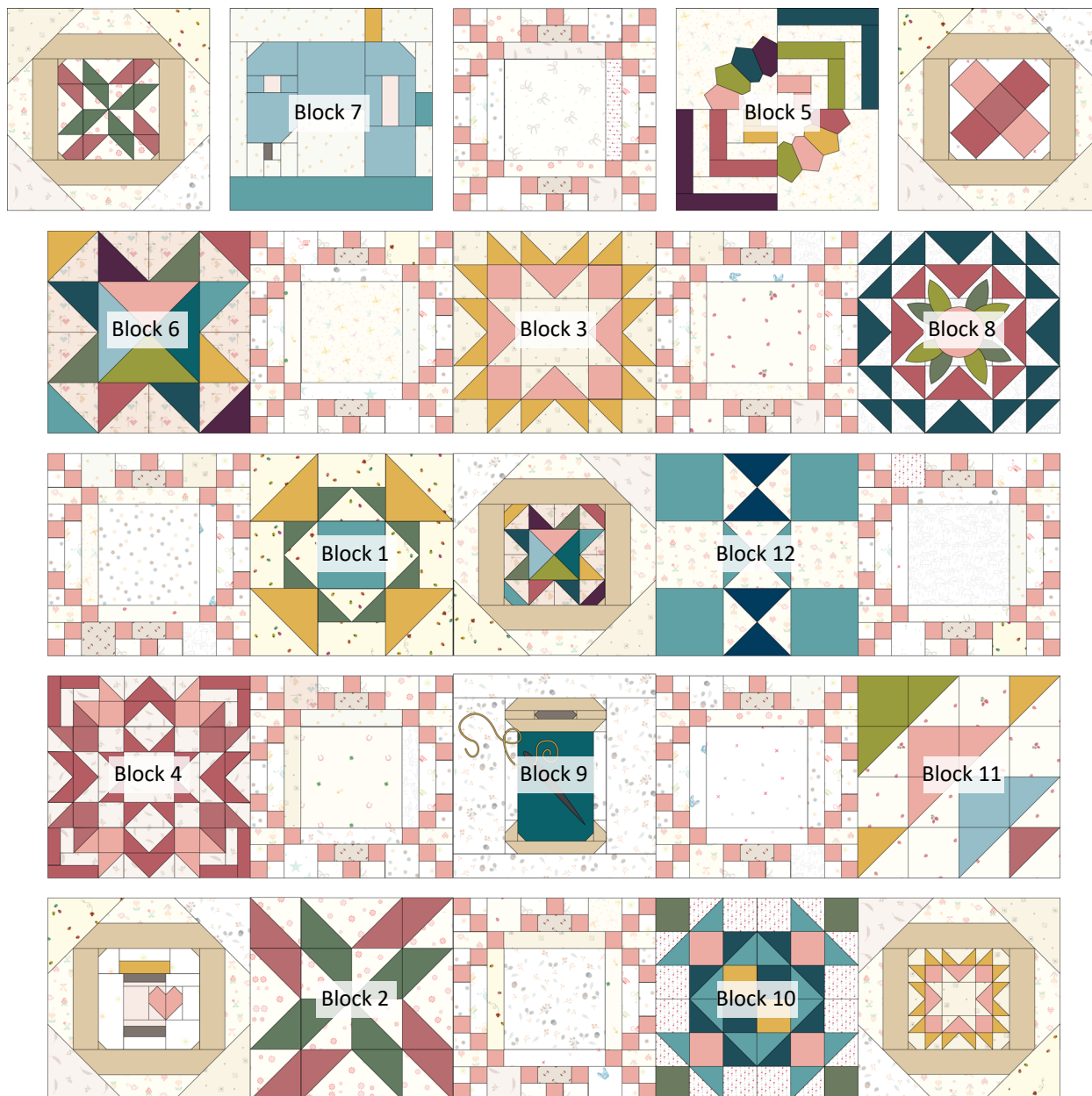

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QUILT ASSEMBLY

13. Arrange (5) Framed Blocks, (12) 12" Blocks (Block 1-12), and (8) Pieced Blocks as shown below. Sew blocks together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make the quilt center.

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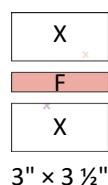
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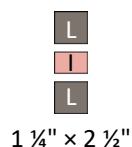
17. Sew (1) **JJ**-rectangle and (1) **G**-rectangle together as shown below. Next, sew (1) **LL**-rectangle to the bottom to make (1) Border End Unit.



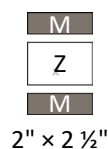
18. Sew (2) **X**-rectangles and (1) **F**-rectangle together as shown below to make (1) Thread Unit.



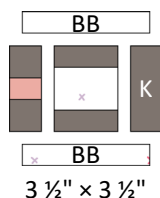
19. Sew (2) **L**-squares and (1) **I**-rectangle together as shown below.



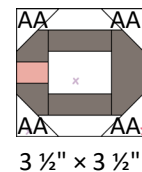
20. Sew (2) **M**-rectangles and (1) **Z**-rectangle together as shown below.



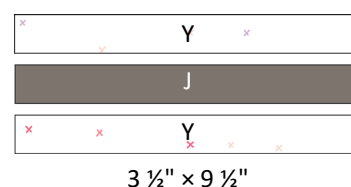
21. Sew (1) Step 19 unit, (1) Step 20 unit, and (1) **K**-rectangle together as shown below. Next, sew (1) **BB**-rectangle to the top and bottom.



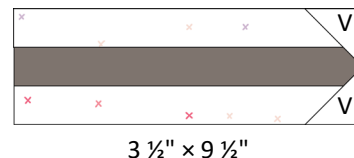
22. Use the SNF method to sew (1) **AA**-square to each corner of the Step 21 unit to make (1) Needle Eye Unit.



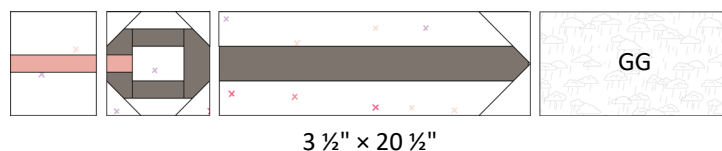
23. Sew (2) **Y**-rectangles and (1) **J**-rectangle together as shown below.



24. Use the SNF method to sew (1) **V**-square to the top right and bottom right corners of the Step 23 unit to make (1) Needle Unit.



25. Sew (1) Thread Unit, (1) Needle Eye Unit, (1) Needle Unit, and (1) **GG**-rectangle together as shown below to make (1) Threaded Needle Unit.



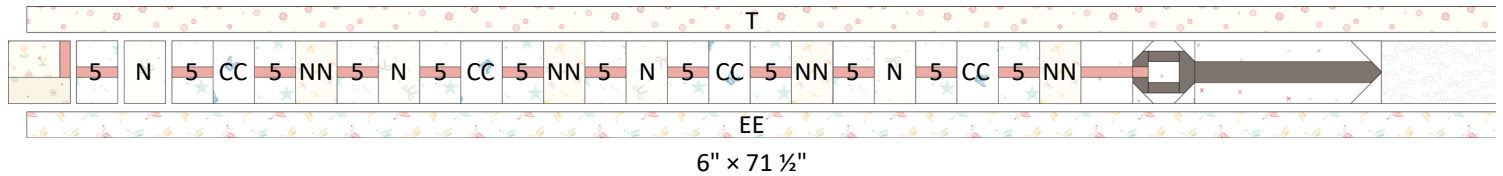
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26. Arrange (1) **T**-strip, (1) Border End Unit, (12) Segment 5s, (4) **N**-rectangles, (4) **CC**-rectangles, (4) **NN**-rectangles, (1) Threaded Needle Unit, and (1) **EE**-strip as shown below. Sew the pieces, units, and segments together into rows. Next, sew the rows together to make (1) Bottom Border Unit.

27. Sew (1) Left Side Border Unit and (1) Right Side Border Unit to the quilt center as shown below, paying careful attention to the orientation of each unit. Next, sew (1) Top Border Unit and (1) Bottom Border Unit to the top and bottom to complete the quilt top.

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FINISHING INSTRUCTIONS

28. Layer the quilt top, batting, and backing. Baste the quilt layers together and quilt as desired. Sew the C120-MELLOWROSE binding strips together end-to-end. Then bind the trimmed, finished quilt using your favorite binding method.
