# OUTDOOR ADVENTURE

**FINISHED QUILT SIZE 80" x 95"**

**Finished Block Size 15" x 15"**

Measurements include  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website [www.rileyblakedesigns.com](http://www.rileyblakedesigns.com) for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 High Adventure Fat Quarter Bundle (FQ-5550-18)

1 yard (95 cm) cream arrow (C5551 Cream)

1 $\frac{1}{4}$  yards (1.15 m) multi tribal (C5553 Multi)

3 $\frac{1}{4}$  yards (3 m) cream wood (C5554 Cream)

1 $\frac{3}{8}$  yards (1.3 m) red stripe (C5555 Red)

Binding 1 yard (95 cm)

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.


### Fat Quarter Bundle

Following the cutting diagram below, cut 4 squares 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", 8 squares 4" x 4", and 10 squares 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the following assorted prints:

tan main, blue arrow, blue plaid, brown plaid  
red plaid, blue stripe

Cut 2 squares 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ", 4 squares 4" x 4", and 5 squares 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the following assorted prints:

red main, tan arrow, blue tribal, multi tribal  
blue wood, brown wood, red stripe, tan stripe



### Cream Arrow

Cut 9 strips 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 3.

### Multi Tribal

Cut 8 strips 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 2.

### Cream Wood

Cut 8 strips 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 1.

Cut 8 strips 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 80 squares 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 8 strips 4" x WOF. Cut the strips into 80 squares 4" x 4".

Cut 5 strips 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 20 squares 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

### Red Stripe

Cut 8 strips 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 80 squares 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 3 strips 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 20 squares 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of pieces as each block is a different combination of fabrics.

### Adventure Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of 2 assorted print 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. With right sides together, place the assorted print 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares on top of a cream wood 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square and a red stripe 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Sew a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press toward the assorted print fabric. This will create 4 half square triangles (2 assorted print/cream wood and 2 assorted print/red stripe). Draw a diagonal line (this will go across the seam) on the back of the 2 assorted print/cream wood half square triangles. With right sides together and nesting the seams, place the assorted print/cream wood half square triangles on top of the assorted print/red stripe half square triangles. Sew a scant  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press. This will create 4 Quarter Square triangles. Using a square ruler with a 45-degree line, find the center at 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " and square up the Quarter Square Triangle to 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

# OUTDOOR ADVENTURE

Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a cream wood 4" square. With right sides together, place a cream wood 4" square on top of an assorted print 4" square. Sew a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the line to make 2 Half Square Triangles. Press. Square up the Half Square Triangles to  $3\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to make 8 Half Square Triangles.

Sew 2 Half Square Triangles, 2 cream wood  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, and 1 red stripe  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square together to create Row A. Repeat to create 2 Row As.

Sew 2 Half Square Triangles, 1 Quarter Square Triangle, and 2 assorted print  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares together to create Row B. Repeat to create 2 Row Bs.



Row B

Sew 2 Quarter Square Triangles, 2 red stripe  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, and 1 assorted print  $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square together to create Row C.



Row C

Sew 2 Row As, 2 Row Bs, and Row C together to create the Adventure Block. Repeat to create 20 Adventure Blocks.

## Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for row placement. Lay out the Adventure blocks in 5 rows of 4 blocks. Sew the rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

## Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

### Border 1

Side borders should be  $75\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be  $66\frac{1}{2}$ ".

### Border 2

Side borders should be  $81\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be  $74\frac{1}{2}$ ".

### Border 3

Side borders should be  $89\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be  $80\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the High Adventure Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
