JEWELS IN THE NIGHT

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 74" x 86"

Finished Block Size 10" x 10"

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Organica Fat Quarter Bundle (FQ-5340-21)

1½ yards (1.4 m) green main (C5340 Green)

¾ yard (70 cm) green peacock (C5341 Green)

3¾ yards (3.45 m) gray woodsy (C5346 Gray)

Binding ¾ yard (70 cm)

Backing 5¼ yards (4.85 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Fat Quarter Bundle

Cut squares 6" x 6" in the corresponding number from each of the following assorted prints:

- 4–green main, 2–purple main, 2–red main
- 2–blue peacock, 2–green peacock
- 2–orange peacock, 2–blue sand dollar
- 2–purple sand dollar, 2–red sand dollar
- 2–blue sandstone, 2–purple sandstone
- 2–red sandstone, 2–blue urchin, 4–purple urchin
- 2–red urchin, 4–green woodsy, 2–orange woodsy

Cut squares 2½" x 2½" in the corresponding number from each of the following assorted prints:

- 3–green main, 1–purple main, 3–red main
- 2–blue peacock, 1–green peacock
- 1–orange peacock, 1–blue sand dollar
- 1–purple sand dollar, 1–red sand dollar
- 1–blue sandstone, 3–purple sandstone
- 1–red sandstone, 1–blue urchin, 3–purple urchin
- 2–red urchin, 3–green woodsy, 2–orange woodsy

Green Main

Cut 8 strips 5½" x WOF for Border 3.

Green Peacock

Cut 7 strips 2½" x WOF for Border 2.

Gray Woodsy

Cut 7 strips 5½" x WOF for Border 1.

Cut 7 strips 6" x WOF. Cut the strips into 40 squares 6" x 6".

Cut 13 strips 2½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 49 rectangles 2½" x 10½".

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of fabrics as each block is a different combination of fabrics.


Jewel Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a gray woodsy 6" square. Place a gray woodsy 6" square on top of an assorted print 6" square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the line. Cut on the line to make 2 Half Square Triangles. Press. Repeat to make 4 Half Square Triangles. Square up the Half Square Triangles to 5½".



Half Square Triangle

Sew 4 Half Square Triangles together to create the Jewel Block. Repeat to make 20 Jewel Blocks.

Posts and Sashing

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for post and sashing placement. Sew an assorted print 2½" square to a gray woody 2½" x 10½" rectangle. Repeat to make a row with 5 posts and 4 sashing rectangles. Make 6 post and sashing rows.

Sashing and Jewel Block

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for sashing and block placement. Sew a gray woody 2½" x 10½" rectangle to a Jewel Block. Repeat to make a row with 5 sashing rectangles and 4 Jewel Blocks. Make 5 sashing and block rows.

Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for row placement. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 62½". Top and bottom borders should be 60½".

Border 2

Side borders should be 72½". Top and bottom borders should be 64½".

Border 3

Side borders should be 76½". Top and bottom borders should be 74½".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Organica Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
