FINISHED QUILT SIZE 58½" x 72½"

Finished Block Size 8" x 8"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Play Ball 2 Fat Quarter Stack (FQ-5130-21)

1¾ yards (1.3 m) blue main (C5130 Blue)

¾ yard (70 cm) multi stripe (C5136 Multi)

3¼ yards (3 m) Riley white solid (C120 Riley White)

Binding ⅝ yard (60 cm)

Backing 4½ yards (4.15 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Fat Quarter Stack

Cut 1 square 4½" x 4½", 4 rectangles 2½" x 4½", and 2 squares 3" x 3" from each of the following assorted prints: blue main, gray main, red main, blue uniform gray uniform, gray stars, navy stars, blue geometric gray geometric, orange geometric, blue XO, red XO, yellow XO, blue plaid, gray plaid, navy plaid

Cut 2 squares 4½" x 4½", 8 rectangles 2½" x 4½", and 4 squares 3" x 3" from red uniform.

Cut 17 squares 2½" x 2½" from orange geometric for posts.

Blue Main

Cut 6 strips 6½" x WOF for Border 2.

Multi Stripe

Cut 5 strips 2½" x WOF for Border 1.

Riley White Solid

Cut 9 strips 2½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 144 squares 2½" x 2½".

Cut 3 strips 3" x WOF. Cut the strips into 36 squares 3" x 3".

Cut 10 strips 2½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 38 rectangles 2½" x 8½" for sashing.

Cut 2 strips 2½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 6 rectangles 2½" x 10½" for sashing.

Cut 2 strips 16" x WOF. Cut the strips into 3 squares 16" x 16". Cut the squares twice diagonally to create 12 Setting Triangles (2 will not be used).

Cut 1 strip 13" x WOF. Cut the strip into 2 squares 13" x 13". Cut the squares once diagonally to create 4 Corner Triangles.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics as each block is a different combination of fabrics.

Star Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 8 Riley white solid 2½" squares. Place a Riley white solid 2½" square on top of an assorted print 2½" x 4½" rectangle and sew on the line. Leave a ¼" seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side. This will make 1 Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 4 Flying Geese Units.



Flying Geese Unit

Sew a Flying Geese Unit to the left and right side of an assorted print 4½" square to create the Center Unit.



Center Unit

Game On

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of an assorted print 3" square. With right sides together, place an assorted print 3" square on top of a Riley white solid 3" square. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the line. Cut on the line to make 2 Half Square Triangles. Press. Square up the Half Square Triangles to $2\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to make 4 Half Squares Triangles.



Half Square Triangle

Sew a Half Square Triangle to each side of a Flying Geese Units to create Unit A. Repeat to create 2 Unit As.



Unit A

Sew a Unit A to the top and bottom of the Center Unit to create the Star Block. Repeat to create 18 Star Blocks.



Star Block

Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for Star Block, Post, Sashing, and Setting Triangle placement. Sew rows together on the diagonal to complete the center of the quilt. Add Corner Triangles. The Corner and Setting Triangles are intentionally cut larger in order to square up the quilt center, leaving $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance on all sides, before adding the borders.

Border

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 57". Top and bottom borders should be 47".

Border 2

Side borders should be 61". Top and bottom borders should be 59".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Play Ball 2 Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
