DOGGY TREATS

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 76" x 88"

Finished Block Size 12" x 12"

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Rover Fat Quarter Bundle (FQ-5210-18)

1 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards (1.65 m) blue main (C5210 Blue)

$\frac{3}{4}$ yard (70 cm) blue stripe (C5215 Blue)

3 yards (2.75 m) cloud solid (C120 Cloud)

Binding $\frac{3}{4}$ yard (70 cm)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Fat Quarter Bundle

Cut 2 rectangles 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and 8 squares 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from each of the following assorted prints:

blue main, tan main, blue dog park, cream dog park
tan dog park, brown bone, cream bone, orange bone
orange paw, tan paw, blue dot, brown dot, cream dot
blue stripe, brown stripe

Blue Main

Cut 8 strips 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 2.

Blue Stripe

Cut 7 strips 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 1.

Cloud Solid

Cut 8 strips 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. From the strips cut 60 rectangles 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics as each block is different.

Treat Block

Draw a line from corner to corner on the assorted print 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares. Place an assorted print 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square on top of a cloud solid 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle with right sides together. Sew on the drawn line. Leave a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side of the cloud solid rectangle to create Unit A. Repeat to create 60 Unit As.



Unit A

Referring to quilt photo for fabric placement, sew 2 Unit As and 1 assorted print 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle together to create the Treat Block. Repeat to make 30 Treat Blocks.



Treat Block

Quilt Center Assembly

Layout the blocks in 6 rows of 5 blocks. Sew the rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 72 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Border 2

Side borders should be 76 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be 76 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Rover Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
