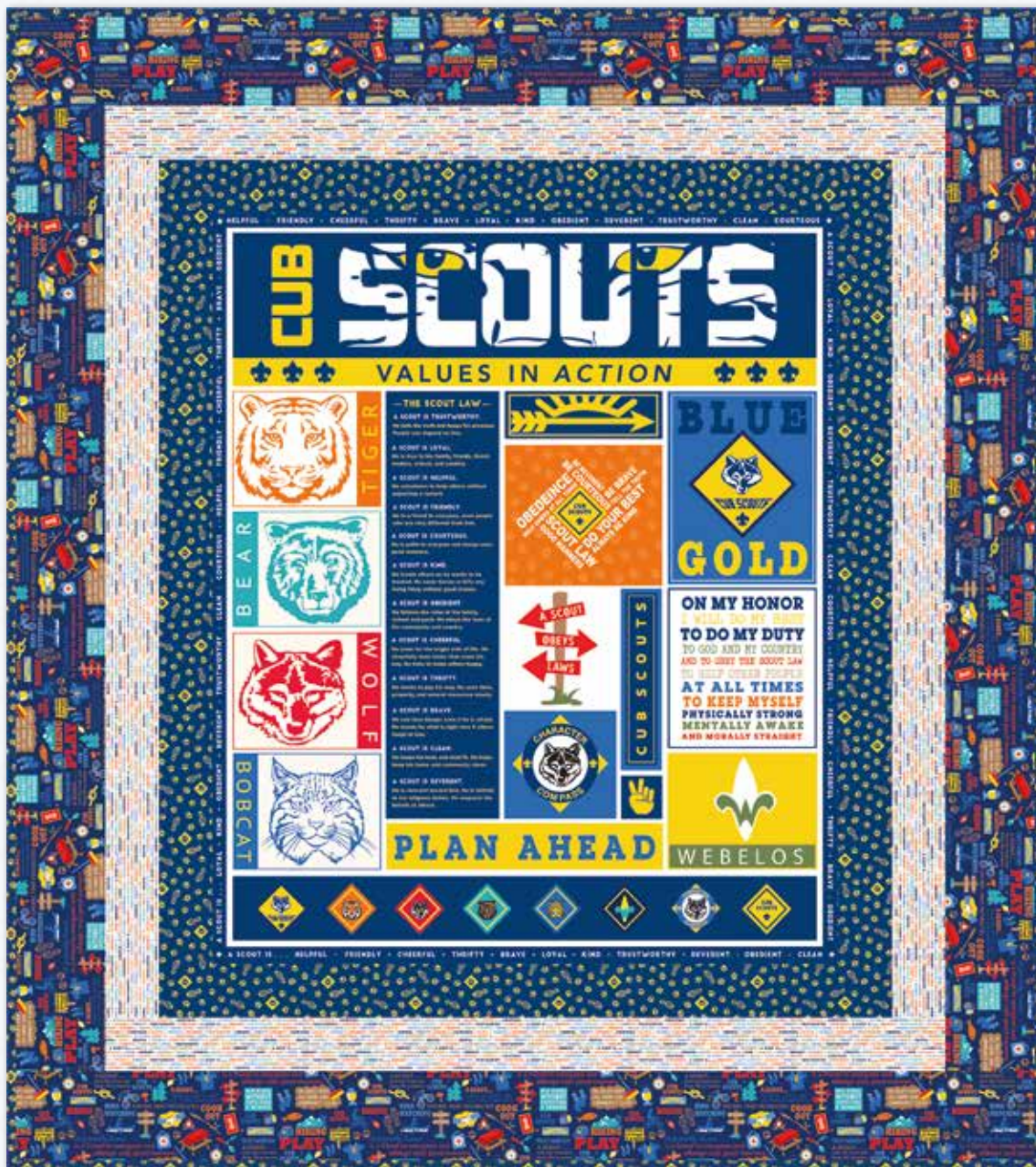


CUB SCOUTS PANEL QUILT



CUB SCOUTS PANEL QUILT

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 57" x 64"

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 navy panel (P7206 Navy)

$1\frac{1}{8}$ yards (1.05 m) navy main (C7200 Navy)

$\frac{5}{8}$ yard (60 cm) navy paws (C7202 Navy)

$\frac{5}{8}$ yard (60 cm) white attributes (C7203 White)

Binding $\frac{5}{8}$ yard (60 cm)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Navy Panel

Cut 1 rectangle $35\frac{1}{2}$ " x $42\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Navy Main

Cut 6 strips $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 3.

Navy Paws

Cut 4 strips $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 1.

White Attributes

Cut 5 strips $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 2.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of fabrics.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be $42\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $41\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Border 2

Side borders should be $48\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $47\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Border 3

Side borders should be $54\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $57\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Cub Scouts Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
