

JEEP TRAILS

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 76" x 79¼"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1½ yards (1.4 m) blue main (C6470 Blue)

1½ yards (1.55 m) blue border (C6471 Blue)

⅝ yard (60 cm) brown badges (C6472 Brown)

⅝ yard (60 cm) blue logo (C6473 Blue)

⅝ yard (25 cm) brown logo (C6473 Brown)

⅝ yard (60 cm) green logo (C6473 Green)

¼ yard (25 cm) blue map (C6474 Blue)

⅝ yard (25 cm) brown map (C6474 Brown)

⅝ yard (25 cm) green map (C6474 Green)

¼ yard (25 cm) blue tread (C6475 Blue)

¼ yard (25 cm) green tread (C6475 Green)

¾ yard (70 cm) sand dollar solid (C120 Sand Dollar)

Binding ¾ yard (70 cm)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Blue Main

Cut 1 strip 3½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 4 rectangles 3½" x 6½".

Cut 8 strips 5½" x WOF for Border 2.

Blue Border

Cut 2 strips 7" x **length of fabric** from the outside edges (next to each selvedge). Cut the strips into 2 rectangles 7" x 54½" for the center rows.

Cut 4 strips 6½" x **length of fabric** for Border 1.

Brown Badges

Cut 4 strips 4¼" x WOF. Sew the strips together and cut 3 rectangles 4¼" x 54½".

Cut 1 strip 3½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 2 rectangles 3½" x 6½".

Blue Logo

Cut 4 strips 3½" x WOF. Sew the strips together and cut 3 rectangles 3½" x 54½".

Cut 2 strips 3½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 9 rectangles 3½" x 6½".

Brown Logo

Cut 1 strip 3½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 3 rectangles 3½" x 6½".

Green Logo

Cut 4 strips 3½" x WOF. Sew the strips together and cut 3 rectangles 3½" x 54½".

Cut 2 strips 3½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 10 rectangles 3½" x 6½".

Blue Map

Cut 2 strips 3½" x WOF. Sew the strips together and cut 1 rectangle 3½" x 54½".

Brown Map

Cut 1 strip 3½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 3 rectangles 3½" x 6½".

Green Map

Cut 1 strip 3½" x WOF. Cut the strip into 5 rectangles 3½" x 6½".

Blue Tread

Cut 2 strips 3½" x WOF. Sew the strips together and cut 1 rectangle 3½" x 54½".

Green Tread

Cut 2 strips 3½" x WOF. Sew the strips together and cut 1 rectangle 3½" x 54½".

Sand Dollar Solid

Cut 7 strips 3½" x WOF. Cut the strips into 72 squares 3½" x 3½".

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics and strips.

Flying Geese Row

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of 2 sand dollar solid 3½" squares. Place a 3½" square on top of an assorted print 3½" x 6½" rectangle and sew on the line. Leave a ¼" seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side. This will make 1 Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 36 Flying Geese Units. Sew 18 Flying Geese Units together to create the Flying Geese Row.

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Quilt Center Assembly

Referring to quilt photo for row placement, sew the assorted print $3\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, the blue border 7" strips, the brown badge $4\frac{1}{4}$ " strips, and the Flying Geese Row together to complete the quilt center.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be $57\frac{3}{4}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $66\frac{1}{2}$ ". Border pieces will be subcut from the 4 blue border strips that were cut $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x the length of fabric.

Sew 3 Flying Geese Units together for the right side border. Sew a blue border $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $16\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the top side of the Flying Geese Units and a blue border $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $32\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangle to the bottom side of the Flying Geese Units to complete the right side border. Adjust the size of the blue border rectangles if necessary to fit your quilt center. Sew the border to the right side of the quilt.

Sew a blue border $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $57\frac{3}{4}$ " strip to the left side of the quilt center.

Sew 3 Flying Geese Units together for the top border. Sew a blue border $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square to the left side of the Flying Geese Units and a blue border $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $51\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the right side of the Flying Geese Units to complete the top border. Adjust the size of the blue border rectangles if necessary to fit your quilt center. Sew the border to the top of the quilt.

Sew 12 Flying Geese Units together for the bottom border. Sew a blue border $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $24\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle to the left side of the Flying Geese Units and a blue border $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square to the right side of the Flying Geese Units to complete the bottom border. Adjust the size of the blue border rectangles if necessary to fit your quilt center. Sew the border to the bottom of the quilt.

Border 2

Side borders should be $69\frac{3}{4}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $76\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Riley Blake fabric from the Four Corners Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
