

Vintage Picnic

FINISHED QUILT SIZE 67" x 83 $\frac{3}{8}$ "

Finished Block Size 12" x 12"

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.pennyrosefabrics.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Church Ladies' Aprons Fat Quarter Stack (FQ-4930-15)

1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards (1.4 m) black main (C4930 Black)

$\frac{5}{8}$ yard (60 cm) blue leaves (C4934 Blue)

3 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards (3.25 m) linen shade (C200-01 Linen Shade)

Binding $\frac{3}{4}$ yard (70 cm)

Backing 5 $\frac{1}{8}$ yards (4.7 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Fat Quarter Stack

Cut 4 squares 4" x 4" and 8 squares 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the following assorted prints:

black main, red main, yellow main, green floral,
blue gingham, orange gingham, red gingham,
red leaves, blue leaves, yellow leaves, black stripe,
red stripe

Black Main

Cut 7 strips 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 2.

Blue Leaves

Cut 6 strips 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 1.

Linen Shade

Cut 8 strips 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 48 rectangles 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 5 strips 4" x WOF. Cut the strips into 48 squares 4" x 4".

Cut 2 strips 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 6 squares 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " for Center Blocks.

Linen Shade (continued)

Cut 2 strips 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 3 squares 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " and 2 squares 10" x 10". Cut the 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares twice diagonally to create 12 Setting Triangles (2 will not be used). Cut the 10" squares once diagonally to create 4 Corner Triangles.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the Quilt Center Diagram for piece placement as each block is a different combination of fabrics.

Star Block

These instructions are to make 1 block. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a linen shade 4" square. Place the linen shade 4" square on top of an assorted print 4" square with right sides together. Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the line to make 2 Half Square Triangles. Press. Repeat to make 8 Half Square Triangles. Square up to 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".




Half Square Triangle

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of an assorted print 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Place an assorted print 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square on top of a linen shade 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle with right sides together and sew on the line. Leave a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance and trim excess. Press. Repeat on the other side of the linen shade rectangle. This will make 1 Flying Geese Unit. Repeat to make 4 Flying Geese Units.



Flying Geese Unit


Sew the 4 assorted print Half Square Triangles together to create the Pinwheel Unit.



Pinwheel Unit

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Sew a Flying Geese Unit to each side of the Pinwheel Unit to create the Center Unit.




Center Unit

Sew the remaining 4 assorted print Half Square Triangles to each side of the 2 remaining Flying Geese Units to create 2 Unit As.



Unit A

Sew a Unit A to the top and bottom of the Center Unit to complete the Star Block. Repeat to create 12 Star Blocks.



Star Block

Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the quilt photo for Star Block, Center Block, and Setting Triangle placement. Sew rows together on the diagonal to complete the center of the quilt. Add Corner Triangles. The Corner and Setting Triangles are intentionally larger in order to square up the quilt center, leaving $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance on all sides.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be $68\frac{3}{8}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $55\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Border 2

Side borders should be $72\frac{3}{8}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $67\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose fabric from the Church Ladies' Aprons Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
