FINISHED QUILT SIZE 66" x 76"

Finished Block Size 5" x 5"

Measurements include $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.rileyblakedesigns.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

2 yards (1.85 m) blue main (C4980 Blue)

1 yard (95 cm) blue leaves (C4982 Blue)

1 yard (95 cm) blue diamond (C4983 Blue)

$\frac{5}{8}$ yard (60 cm) blue ovals (C4984 Blue)

$1\frac{1}{8}$ yards (1.05 m) blue daisy (C4985 Blue)

$\frac{5}{8}$ yard (60 cm) blue bonbon (C4986 Blue)

$1\frac{1}{8}$ yards (1.05 m) tan bonbon (C4986 Tan)

Binding $\frac{3}{4}$ yard (70 cm)

Backing $4\frac{3}{4}$ yard (4.35 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Blue Main

Fussy cut 4 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x LOF (parallel to the selvedge) for Border 1.

Fussy cut 4 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x LOF (parallel to the selvedge) for Border 3.

Blue Leaves

Cut 2 strips $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 12 squares $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 7 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 2.

Blue Diamond

Cut 2 strips $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 14 squares $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Cut 7 strips $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF for Border 4.

Blue Ovals

Cut 3 strips $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 16 squares $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Blue Daisy

Cut 5 strips $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 30 squares $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Blue BonBon

Cut 3 strips $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 18 squares $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $5\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Tan BonBon

Cut 5 strips $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF. Cut the strips into 30 squares $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ ".

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to quilt photo for placement of fabrics and blocks.

Hourglass Block

Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of a blue daisy $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square. With right sides together, place a blue daisy $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square on top of a tan bonbon $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press toward the tan bonbon fabric. This will create 2 half square triangles. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner (this will go across the seam) on the back of 1 of the half square triangles. With right sides together and nesting the seams, place the half square triangle with the diagonal line on top of the other half square triangle. Sew a $\frac{1}{4}$ " on each side of the drawn line. Cut on the drawn line. Press. This will create 2 Hourglass Blocks. Using a square ruler with a 45-degree line, find the center at $2\frac{3}{4}$ " and square up the Hourglass Blocks to $5\frac{1}{2}$ ". Repeat to create 60 Hourglass Blocks.

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Quilt Center Assembly

Referring to quilt photo for block placement, lay out the Hourglass Blocks and the assorted print 5½" squares in 12 rows of 10 blocks. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be 60½". Top and bottom borders should be 54½".

Border 2

Side borders should be 64½". Top and bottom borders should be 58½".

Border 3

Side borders should be 68½". Top and bottom borders should be 62½".

Border 4

Side borders should be 72½". Top and bottom borders should be 66½".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose fabric from the Harrington Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
