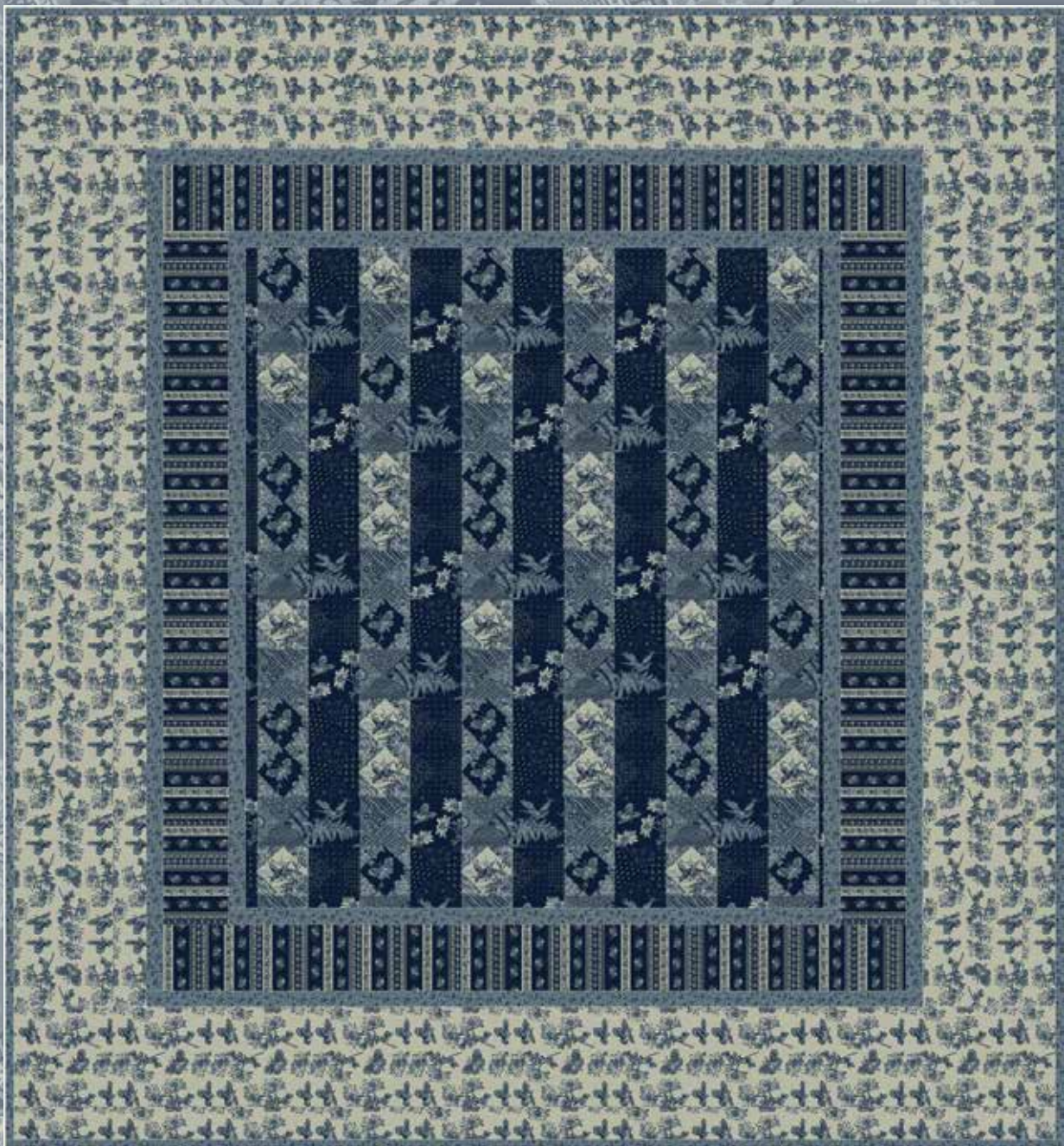

# In the Meadow

## FINISHED QUILT SIZE 63" x 68"

Measurements include ¼" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website [www.pennyrosefabrics.com](http://www.pennyrosefabrics.com) for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

## FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1¼ yards (1.15 m) blue main (C4490 Blue)

1⅝ yards (1.5 m) light blue butterfly (C4492 Light Blue)

¾ yard (70 cm) blue stripe (C4493 Blue)

½ yard (50 cm) light blue leaves (C4495 Light Blue)

Binding ⅝ yard (60 cm)

Backing 4 yards (3.7 m)

## CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

### Blue Main

Cut 1 rectangle 35½" wide x 40½" tall.

### Light Blue Butterfly

Cut 6 strips 8½" x WOF for Border 4.

### Blue Stripe

Cut 5 strips 4½" x WOF for Border 2.

### Light Blue Leaves

Cut 9 strips 1½" x WOF for Borders 1 and 3.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of fabrics.

### Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

### Border 1

Side borders should be 40½". Top and bottom borders should be 37½".

### Border 2

Side borders should be 42½". Top and bottom borders should be 45½".

### Border 3

Side borders should be 50½". Top and bottom borders should be 47½".

### Border 4

Side borders should be 52½". Top and bottom borders should be 63½".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose fabric from the Meadow Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
