Sweet Stuff



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FINISHED QUILT SIZE 64" x 64"

Finished Block Size 8" x 8"

Measurements include 1/4" seam allowance.

Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated.

Please check our website www.pennyrosefabrics.com for any revisions before starting this project. This pattern requires a basic knowledge of quilting technique and terminology. The quilt and block diagrams portrayed are virtual images. The layout and look of your project may differ when using actual fabric.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS

1 Milk, Sugar & Flower Fat Quarter Stack (FQ-4340-21)

1 1/4 yards (1.15 m) blue main (C4340 Blue)

2 1/2 yards (2.3 m) clean white solid (C100-01 Clean White)

Binding 5/8 yard (60 cm)

Backing 4 yards (3.7 m)

CUTTING REQUIREMENTS

Please read instructions first before cutting. Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces.

Fat Quarter Stack

Cut squares 5" x 5" in the corresponding number from the following prints:

- 10–blue main, 2–pink main, 2–mint friends, 2–yellow friends
- 2–pink floral, 2–red floral, 2–mint magpie, 2–pink magpie
- 2–pink stripe, 2–blue drops, 2–yellow drops, 2–blue petals
- 2–mint petals, 2–orange petals

Cut strips 2 1/2" x 21" in the corresponding number from the following prints:

- 1–pink main, 1–mint friends, 1–pink friends, 1–yellow friends
- 1–pink floral, 2–red floral, 1–mint magpie, 1–pink magpie
- 1–mint stripe, 1–pink stripe, 1–red stripe, 1–blue drops
- 1–pink drops, 2–yellow drops, 1–blue petals, 1–mint petals
- 1–orange petals

Blue Main

Cut 6 strips 6 1/2" x WOF for Border 2.

Clean White Solid

Cut 10 strips 2 1/2" x WOF. Cut the strips in half so you have 20 strips approximately 2 1/2" x 21".

Cut 5 strips 5" x WOF. Cut the strips into 36 squares 5" x 5".

Cut 6 strips 2 1/2" x WOF for Border 1.

QUILT ASSEMBLY

Refer to the quilt photo for placement of fabrics and blocks.

Sweet Stuff Block

Sew a print 2 1/2" x 21" strip and a clean white solid 2 1/2" x 21" strip together. Press. Repeat with remaining 2 1/2" x 21" print and clean white strips. Cut the strip sets into 2 1/2" segments in the corresponding number from the following prints:

- 8–pink main, 8–mint friends, 8–pink friends
- 8–yellow friends, 8–pink floral, 12–red floral
- 8–mint magpie, 8–pink magpie, 8–mint stripe
- 8–pink stripe, 8–red stripe, 8–blue drops
- 8–pink drops, 12–yellow drops, 8–blue petals
- 8–mint petals, 8–orange petals

Sew the segments together to create 72 Four-Patch Units.



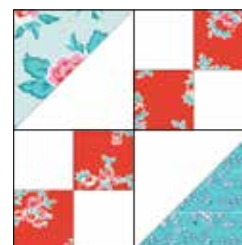
Four-Patch Unit

Draw a line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the clean white solid 5" squares. Place a clean white solid 5" square on top of a print 5" square with right sides together. Sew 1/4" on each side of the line. Cut on the lines to make 2 Half Square Triangles. Press. Repeat to make 72 Half Square Triangles. Square up the Half Square Triangles to 4 1/2".



Half Square Triangle

Refer to quilt photo for placement of Four-Patch Units and Half Square Triangles as each block is different. Sew together 2 Half Square Triangles and 2 Four-Patch Units to create the Sweet Stuff Block. Repeat to create 36 Sweet Stuff Blocks.



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Quilt Center Assembly

Refer to the quilt photo for Sweet Stuff Block placement. Lay out blocks in 6 rows of 6 blocks. Sew rows together to complete the center of the quilt.

Borders

Seam allowances vary so measure through the center of the quilt before cutting border pieces. Sew border strips together end to end if necessary to get the length needed. Sew side borders first.

Border 1

Side borders should be $48\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $52\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Border 2

Side borders should be $52\frac{1}{2}$ ". Top and bottom borders should be $64\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Finish quilt by layering the quilt top, batting, and back. Bind with your favorite Penny Rose fabric from the Milk, Sugar & Flower Collection. Have fun with your colors and enjoy the journey of making your quilt.
